TWO ARRESTED BY DEPUTIES FOLLOWING RUFFIN HOME BREAK-IN

[Reidsville, N.C.]— On Sunday, March 5^{th} , 2017, at 9:48 a.m., Sheriff's Deputies were called to respond to 1473 Guerrent Springs Rd. Ruffin, N.C. about a break-in to the home and theft that had occurred within the previous two hours.

Upon his arrival, Deputy M. Edwards spoke with Dennis Strader and discovered that entry to the residence was apparently made through a basement window that had been broken and a safe containing various items and a RCA brand digital tablet had been taken from the home. Detective A. Webster was then called to assist in the investigation and learned from an eye witness that JOSHUA BRYAN CLARK, 22, (grandson of the home owner), and ELIZABETH ANN TURNER, 23, both of 304 Cook Florist Rd. Reidsville, N.C. had been seen entering the residence during the time period that the break-in was believed to have occurred. CLARK and TURNER were located and interviewed by Detective Webster. The stolen safe was located shortly thereafter in the wooded area of Pearson Cemetery Rd.

CLARK and Turner were both charged with felonious Breaking and Entering, felonious Larceny after Breaking and Entering, felony Larceny and misdemeanor Possession of Stolen Property. JOSHUA CLARK was placed in the Rockingham County Jail under a \$23,500 secured bond. ELIZABETH TURNER was placed in the Rockingham County Jail under a \$5,000 secured bond.
