



Sheriff's Investigators Seek ID of Man that Stole Soft Drinks and Gas from Ruffin Convenience Store

[Wentworth, N.C.]— Rockingham County Sheriff's Investigators are seeking the identity of the man pictured below in this release who, according to a report from Ruffin Grocery, stole \$72.89 of gasoline and a case of Coca-Cola soft drinks from the store.

According to the store employee, the person pictured below came into the store on Sunday Sept. 17th at around 4:45pm, picked up a case of Coca-Cola soft drinks and told the store clerk he was going to fill his truck with gas and come back in and pay for both. When he finished fueling his Dodge truck (also pictured) he drove off without paying for the sodas or the gasoline.
