



Sheriff's Investigators Seek Leads in Theft of Batteries from Heavy Equipment at Church Site

[Wentworth, N.C.]— Rockingham County Sheriff's Investigators are seeking leads in a theft of two 12 volt batteries and a 24 volt crossbar from a 2005 Yellow in color CATERPILLAR 120G Grader. The grader was being used at the Mount Carmel Church construction site located at 361 Mt. Carmel Church Rd. Ruffin, N.C.. The grader had been parked about 30 feet from the intersection of Mount Carmel Rd. and Guerrant Springs Rd. between Friday Sept. 22nd at 5 p.m. and Saturday Sept. 23rd at around 7:50 a.m. when the lock on the battery box was discovered cut and the batteries gone. This is the second time in the past few weeks that batteries have been stolen from equipment parked at the church construction site.
