
How to Plant a Bareroot Seedling





Growth should start within the same year planted.



Keep roots moist



Keep weeds down



Keep roots out of sun



Keep moist when in and out of soil



Grows into a beautiful plant



Rent tree planting bar

Tree Planting Guide

- 1 Keep roots moist at all times. Dry roots die.
- 2 Plunge bar at 70 degree angle and push forward till upright.
- 3 Place seedlings against flat side of planting hole.
- 4 Plunge bar into ground 3 inches from seedling and pull bar back first to pack dirt near roots.
- 5 Push handle of bar forward to pack soil at top of roots.
- 6 To close hole, plunge bar into ground 3 inches from last hole.
- 7 Heel in soil with foot to remove air pockets from the soil.
- **8** Water entire backfill area.
- **9** When feasible, place mulch around seedling, keeping mulch away from trunk.
