TREE PROTECTOR INSTALL ATION GUIDE

After planting the tree in accordance with proper tree planting directions, pound or press the stake into the ground at a distance from the tree equal to about one-half the diameter of the protector.

The stake should be on the side of the tree toward the prevailing wind; e.g., if the prevailing wind is from the west, the stake should be on the west side of the tree. In Northwest Minnesota the prevailing wind is from the Northwest.

The top of the stake should be one to two inches higher than the top locktie that secures the protector to the stake.

Miracle Tubes

- Miracle Tubes come nested with lockties already in place. Their diameters range from about 3 1/4 to about 4 1/2 inches. Choose the smaller diameter tubes for smaller trees and the larger diameter tubes for larger trees.
- Carefully slide the protector down over the top of the tree and the lockties down over the stake. PLEASE NOTE: If the trees have branches, carefully gather them together with their tips facing up before lowering the protector.
- 3. Make sure the bottom of the protector is in good contact with the ground.
- 4. Look down inside the protector to make sure the tree's terminal bud is pointing straight up.
- 5. Tighten ties.
