Peer-Based Mentoring

Program Overview

The Peer Mentoring program follows a one-to-one model where Youth Mentors are paired with Youth Mentees, offering valuable support and leadership opportunities for both.

Role of the Mentor

The Peer Mentor provides leadership and guidance to their Peer Mentee, offering social and emotional support in a school environment. Partners for Youth staff provides training and ongoing support throughout to ensure the success of both the Mentor and Mentee.

Referral Process

Students can be referred to the program by a school counselor and/or a teacher.

Program Details

Location: Routt County at select schools.

Commitment: Volunteer Mentors work with their Mentee for an average of 1 hour per week over the course of a 12-week program.

Eligibility for Mentors: Mentors must be at least 2 school grades above the Mentee's grade level. Mentors must pass the application and interview process.
