Position Title: Paid School Based Mentor – Part-time (Seasonal)

Position School Based Mentors (SBMs) provide one-to-one mentoring for 10 target students. Additional programming will be determined by school needs.

Terms: Sept 2020- May/June 2021, Average of 20-25 hours/week - \$15/hour

Location: Placement in one/two of three Routt County schools (including Steamboat Springs High School, South Routt Middle/High School, and North Routt Charter School). Due to Covid-19, work location/virtual options are evolving and are based on school, local and state guidelines.

Desired Qualifications

- High school diploma required; Bachelor's degree preferred
- Experience/interest in serving school aged, underserved youth
- A desire to pursue a career in the field of education, counseling and/or nonprofit management
- Clean criminal record and driving background – all members must pass a background check
- Reliable vehicle & driver's license strongly recommended

General Function and Responsibilities

- SBMs will build relationships and implement programming that supports the development of young people in elementary, middle and high school.
- Mentors will be screened and trained prior to school placements.
- Partners provides ongoing mentor support, supervision and case management.
- Mentors provide guidance, support and tutoring to their caseload of 10 target students.
- As school requested/available, SBMs implement in-school and after-school clubs and activities; both target and non-target students are encouraged to participate in SBM Program recreational, life skill, and service learning programming.
