They also facilitate a Peer Mentoring program specific to their school. Bi-weekly mentor meetings/professional development at the Partners office in Steamboat Springs.

- Mentors are trained in supporting target students through the use of Individual Mentoring Plans, 1:1 support (social emotional, academic, behavioral), classroom support, and other activities that support academic success.
- InSPIRE mentors may facilitate a Peer Mentoring program appropriate for their specific school site.
- As school-requested/available, InSPIRE mentors implement in-school and after-school clubs and activities.
- InSPIRE mentors use the Partners online database to keep appropriate records of mentoring such as parent communications, student session notes, and activity attendance.
