## Community-Based Mentoring

### Program Overview

In our Community-Based Mentoring program, youth ages 7-17 are matched with trained volunteers from our community who serve as Mentors. The program provides youth with a supportive, positive relationship to help them grow and thrive.

### Role of the Mentor

The Mentor serves as a friend, advocate, and role model to the Mentee, helping guide them through personal and social challenges while fostering positive growth. Mentors receive comprehensive training and ongoing support from Partners' Case Managers, ensuring they have the tools and resources to succeed in their role.

### Referral Process

Youth are referred to the program by professionals in the community, such as school counselors, therapists, Department of Human Services, and others.

**Commitment:** Mentors work with youth for an average of 3 hours per week for at least one year.

**Eligibility for Mentors:** Must be 18+, pass a background screening, and have reliable transportation within the community.
