At GeneScreen, our mission is to improve access to genetic counselling and carrier testing services for all Canadians.

HOW IT WORKS

01 REFER

Fax a referral or simply share our booking link with your patient. Both work. We offer evening and weekend appointments that patients can self-schedule. The initial consultation is always free, and our pricing is transparent.

02 COUNSEL

A qualified genetic counsellor sees every patient

Pre- and post-test sessions with a board-certified genetic counsellor. Informed consent and patient autonomy are always prioritized.

03 TEST

The right panel, the right lab

We choose the best CAP/CLIA-accredited lab for the patient's indication, and the saliva collection kit arrives at your patient's doorstep within 2 days. Results are typically reported within 2-3 weeks.

04 REPORT

Summary back to you

Results, risk assessment and recommended next steps are shared with your patient you, along with a full pedigree, and all test reports.

WHAT WE OFFER

- **Expanded carrier screening** for recessive and X-linked conditions, up to ~2,000 conditions
- **Reproductive partner screening** with couple-based risk assessment
- **Targeted familial-variant testing** when a variant is already known in the family
- **Healthy-person hereditary cancer screening** across 50+ genes
- **Result interpretation and navigation**, including what to do next and who to see

What we do not offer: Diagnostic testing. If your patient has symptoms, a personal cancer diagnosis, or needs a diagnostic workup, they belong in the Provincial Genetics system. We will tell you plainly if that is the case and suggest the most appropriate referral.

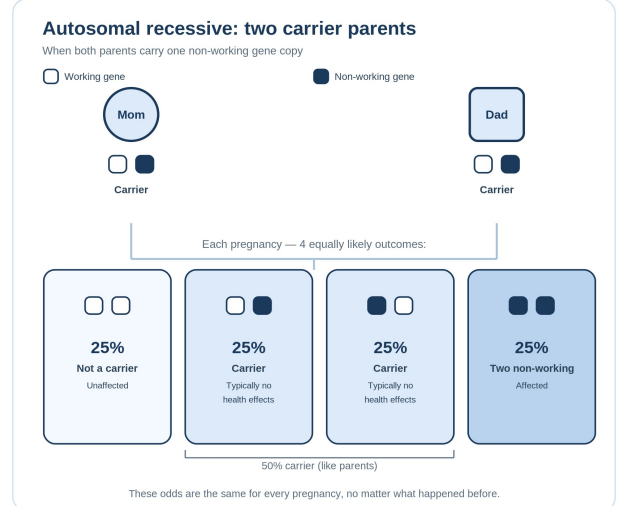

Could you and your partner carry the same non-working gene?

Almost all of us carry a few non-working genes for rare genetic conditions without ever knowing it. Carriers are healthy, usually with no symptoms and nothing in the family history to hint at it. The chance of having a child with a serious genetic condition rises when **both** partners happen to carry a non-working copy of the same gene, or when a female partner carries an X-linked genetic condition. Expanded carrier testing lets you and your partner find this out before starting a family (or early in pregnancy), while your options are open. GeneScreen helps you understand your risk from the comfort of home, with a board-certified genetic counsellor beside you from start to finish.



WHAT WE OFFER

Genetic counselling

Worried about something in your family history, or holding a test report nobody has explained? A board-certified counsellor helps you understand what it means and decide what to do.

Expanded carrier screening

A simple DNA test covering up to ~2,000 recessive conditions. Best done before pregnancy, and still useful in early pregnancy.

Targeted testing for a known family condition

If a specific variant has already been found in your family, we arrange focused testing and explain what your result means for you and your relatives.

Hereditary cancer screening for healthy people

Checks 50+ genes linked to hereditary cancer risk. Not suitable if you have already had a cancer diagnosis yourself.

EXAMPLES OF CONDITIONS WE DETECT

X-linked (Carrier female can have an affected son): Fragile X syndrome, Duchenne muscular dystrophy, hemophilia

Recessive (when both partners are carriers): Cystic fibrosis, spinal muscular atrophy, Tay-Sachs disease, albinism

HOW IT WORKS

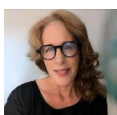
