- Manda training annually. Instructions and details are located inside this newsletter. In accordance with California Senate Bill 848 (SB 848), all new and returning volunteers must complete this clearance process before stepping onto campus. Direct any questions to the CNUSD Volunteer Website or your school site.
- CNUSD and CNTA Negotiations: As a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization, our official position remains completely Neutral. Please see the attached document for leadership guidance during this time.
- FutureFund Connect: California State PTA has officially transitioned from PTAEZ to FutureFund Connect for free document retention and bylaws submissions. Presidents should check their email (and spam folders) for login details at futurefund.com/connect. (Note: Financials in myPTEZ remain available only for paid subscriptions).



Immediate Action Items (Do This Now if you haven't already)

If you need help with any of these steps, please reach out to us! 😊

- Confirm Roster Details: Input all officer contact information into Future Fund Connect.
- Update System Lineups: Update leader names in the e-membership system as soon as they are elected or appointed.
- Review the Playbook: Review your bylaws. Units, councils, and districts must review them annually and submit through channels every five years.
- Wrap Up Last Season: Prepare year-end financial reports as soon as the June bank statement is reconciled.
- Conduct the Financial Review: Complete the year-end financial review immediately following the June bank statement reconciliation. Learn the official rules at toolkit.capta.org/financial-review-procedure-and-recommendations.
- Manage the Treasury: Update bank accounts and check-signer information at your bank. Update the bank owner name in the electronic membership platform.



Launching the Regular Season (August)

- Launch the Membership Drive: Begin your membership campaign and remit memberships through channels. Everyone needs a minimum of 15 members to operate by October 15th. Visit the Membership Toolbox for PTA leaders for top-tier tools and resources.
- Score on Compliance: Upload your completed compliance documents to our monthly google forms. This includes your current fiscal year budget, prior year end-of-year financial review, and prior year financial report (budget to actuals).
- Protect the Team: Watch for the annual insurance premium amount announcement at capta.org/insurance.
