1. Respect and Reverence

- Show respect for all individuals, including peers, teachers, guides, and community members.
- Treat sacred sites, historical locations, and religious artifacts with reverence.
- Speak and act respectfully, avoiding profanity, gossip, or offensive humor.

2. Spiritual Engagement

- Wear modest and appropriate clothing for all school and tour activities.

- Follow specific guidelines for visits to churches, religious sites, or formal events.

6. Safety and Responsibility

- Stay with the group during the tour and follow all safety guidelines.
- Do not bring or use prohibited items (e.g., drugs, alcohol, weapons).
- Report any unsafe or concerning behavior to a leader or teacher immediately.

7. Stewardship and Cleanliness

- Keep personal belongings and shared spaces neat and clean.
- Show respect for the environment and property of others.
- Leave places better than you found them, especially sacred or historical sites.

8. Use of Technology

- Use phones, tablets, and cameras responsibly and only when permitted.
- Do not use technology to distract from the spiritual or educational purpose of the tour or school activities.

9. Accountability

- Accept responsibility for your actions and their impact on others.
- Understand that violations of this code may result in disciplinary action, including removal from the tour or school activities.
