Below are important expectations and guidelines to help you prepare and make the most of this tour.

Living Arrangements

- You will be living full-time in RVs for the duration of the tour.
 - Students will be divided by gender and assigned accordingly.
 - Showers and bathroom facilities will be inside the RVs—please conserve water and use resources wisely.
 - RVs will serve as both living space and a place for personal quiet time and small group devotionals.
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Meals

- All meals will be provided by the ministry.
 - Meals will be served on a schedule, and all students are expected to be punctual.
 - Assistance with setup, cleanup, and general food service will be part of team responsibilities.
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Chores & Teamwork

- All students are expected to participate in daily chores to maintain cleanliness, order, and harmony in the RVs and shared spaces.

- Tasks may include dishwashing, RV cleaning, food prep help, and more.
 - Teamwork is crucial—we are one body with many parts, and every task is important.
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Schedule & Time Management

- A **strict daily schedule** will be followed to maximize your time for evangelism, spiritual growth, and rest.
 - Time will be allocated for:
 - Morning devotions & prayer
 - Evangelism outreach
 - Meals and chores
 - Team meetings & discipleship
 - Worship
 - Free time (see below)
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Evangelism

- You will engage in **public street evangelism** throughout various cities and communities in Greece.
 - This includes sharing your testimony, engaging in prayer, worship, and distributing materials as needed.
 - Be prepared for a variety of responses and environments—this is a step of faith and obedience.
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Outdoor & Weather Conditions

- Expect to be exposed to outdoor elements including heat, sun, rain, and wind.
- Please pack appropriately: sunscreen, water bottles, modest and functional clothing, rain jackets, etc.
- There may be days with physical walking and long hours outside—steward your energy and health wisely.

Technology & Free Time

- There will be **designated windows of time** for personal phone calls and technology use.
- Outside of these periods, technology should be put away to foster focus, rest, and connection with God and your team.

Team Leadership & Guidance

- Each student group will have **assigned team leaders** responsible for guidance, mentorship, and spiritual support.
- Leaders will help facilitate quiet times, oversee chores, and ensure expectations are met.
- They are here for your growth—seek them out with questions, struggles, or prayer needs.

Spiritual Focus

- Be ready to grow, be challenged, and encounter God in new ways.
- Quiet times, group worship, and team reflection are essential parts of the schedule.
- We encourage full participation with a teachable heart and a desire to be transformed.
