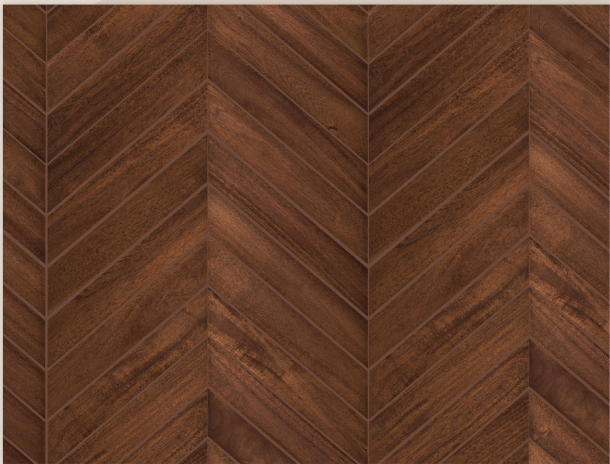

What is the best grade for Wood Flooring?

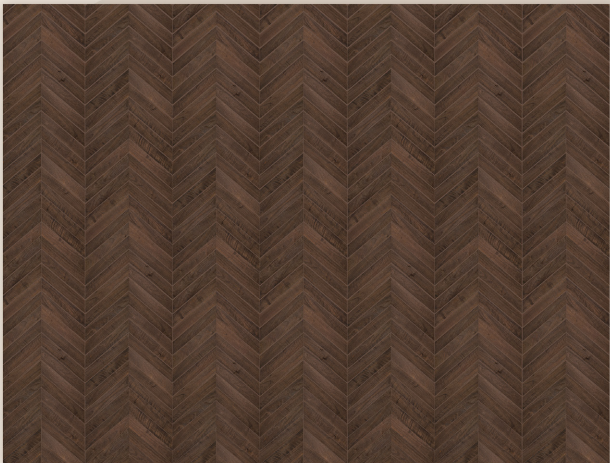
Higher grades of wood flooring are of higher quality and may have fewer knots, cracks, or other imperfections. Here are some common grading systems for wood flooring:

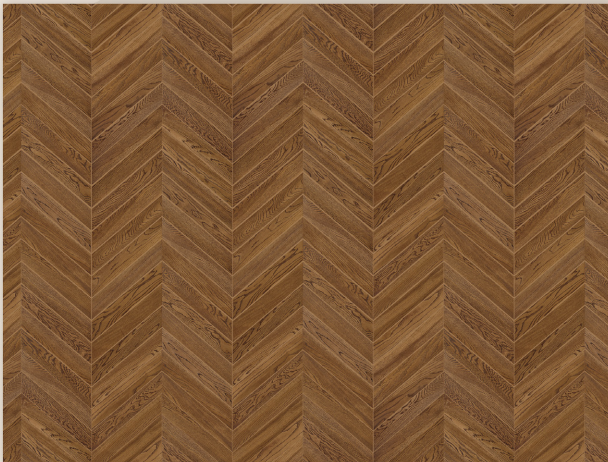

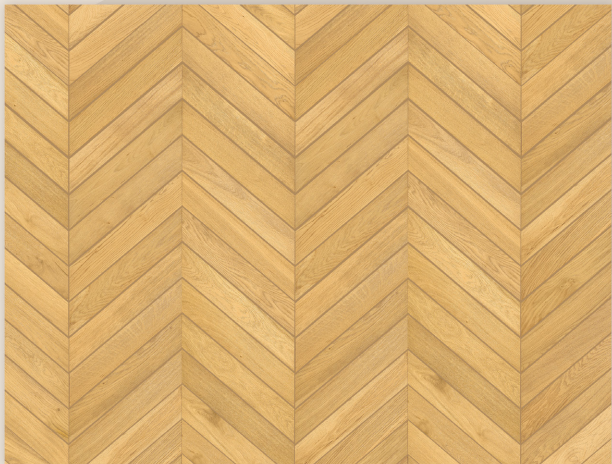

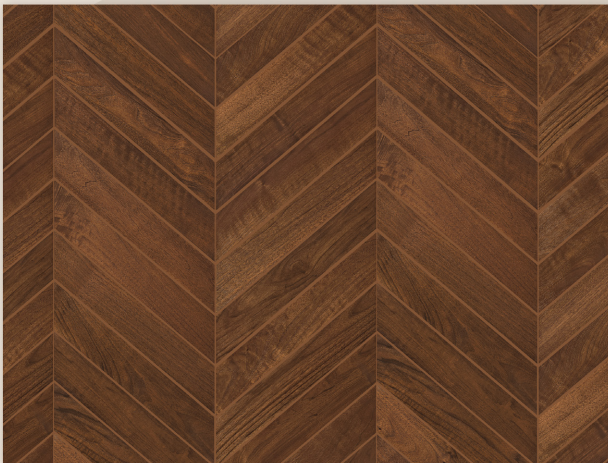
