Write the letters of the music alphabet going up from F.

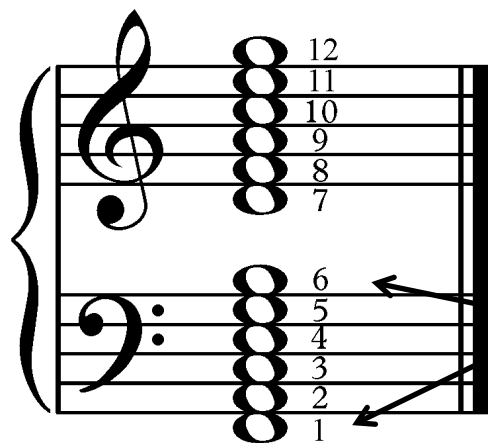
Circle skips in the music alphabet starting with the letter F.

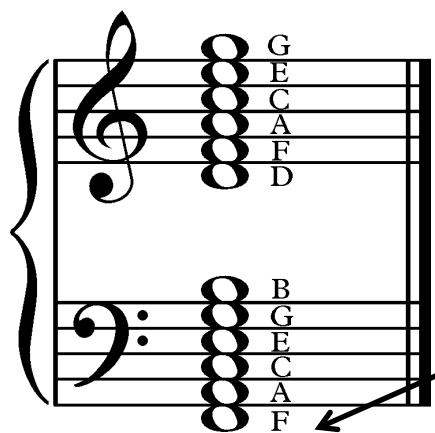

Space Notes



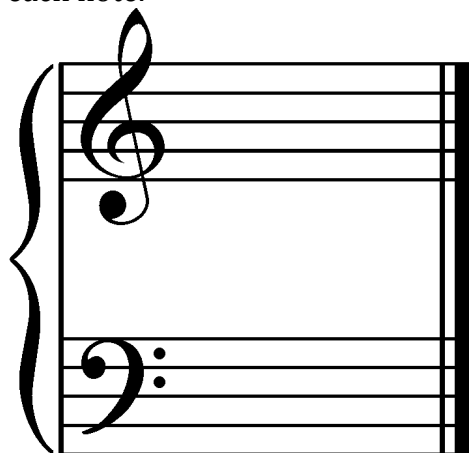
Notice that there are twelve space notes on the Grand Staff.

The letter names of the space notes use skips in the alphabet starting with F.

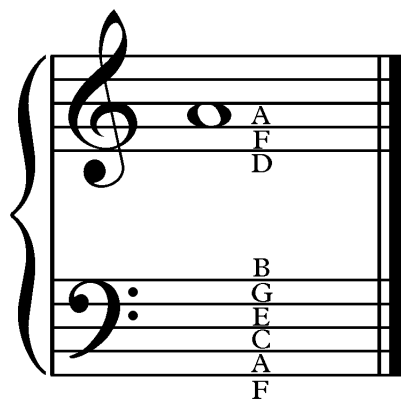

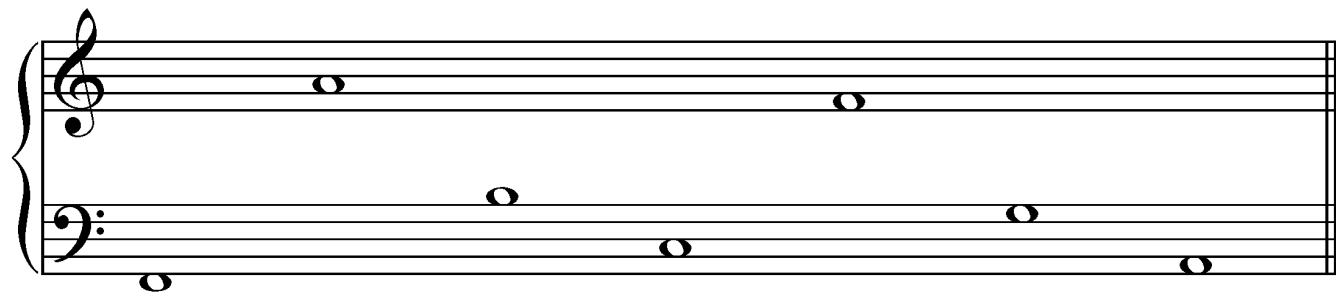
How to Name a Space Note

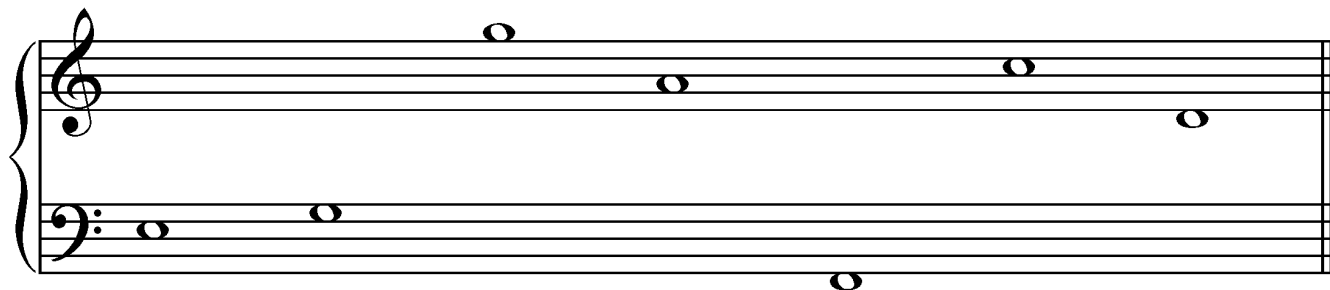


When naming space notes on the Grand Staff, name skips in the alphabet starting with F.

Write the letter name of each note.

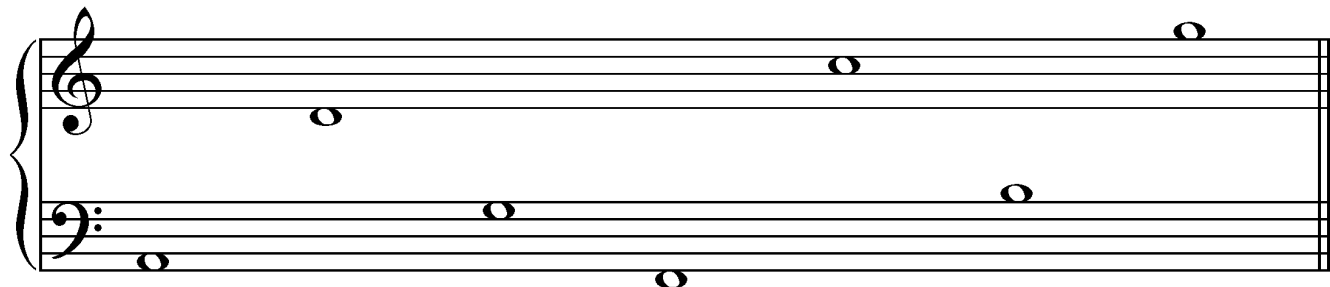


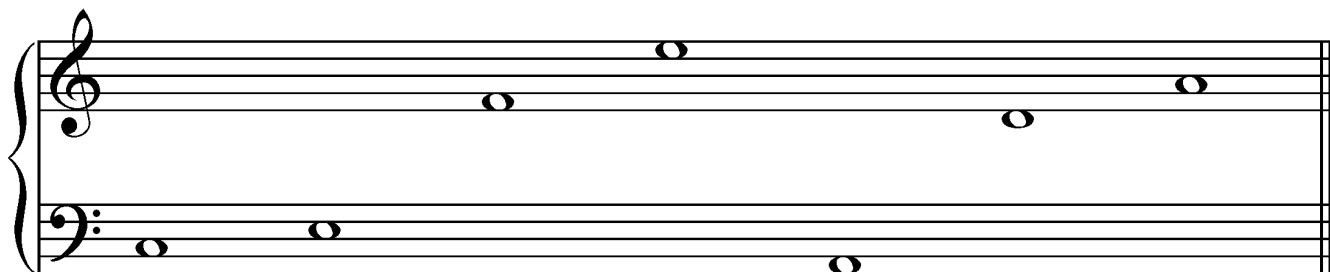


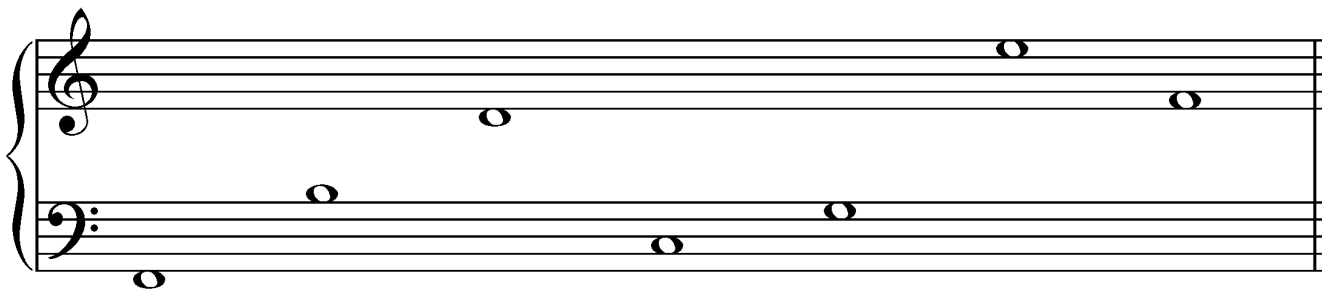

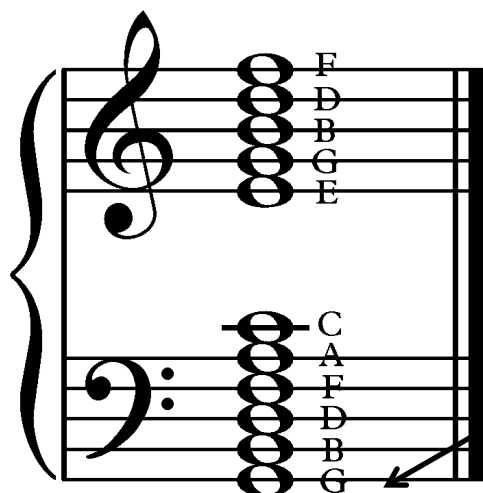


Line Notes

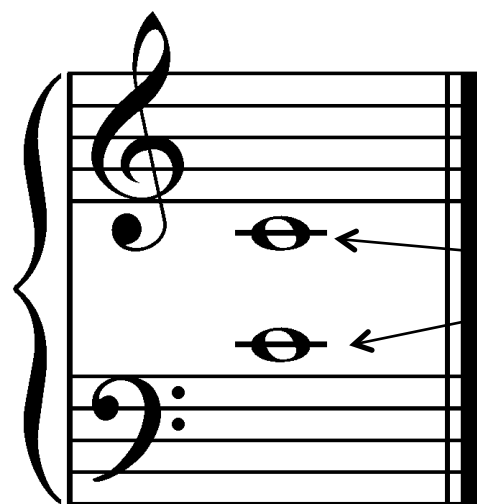


Notice that there are eleven line notes on the Grand Staff.

There is a note on each line in addition to one line note in the middle of the staff.



The letter names of the line notes use skips in the alphabet starting with G.



Ledger lines are used to extend the staff. Middle C is notated on a ledger line in the middle of the Grand Staff.

These two notes are both middle C.

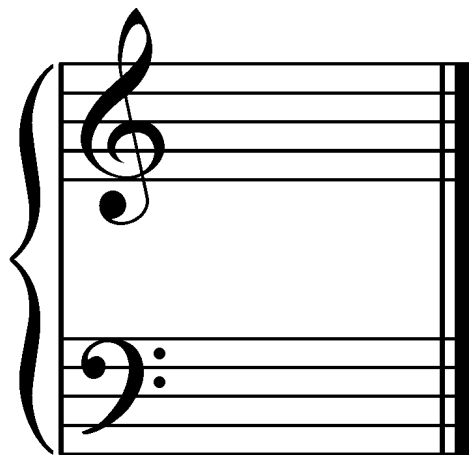
If middle C is notated closer to the treble clef, it means to use the right hand to play the note.

If middle C is notated closer to the bass clef, it means to use the left hand to play the note.

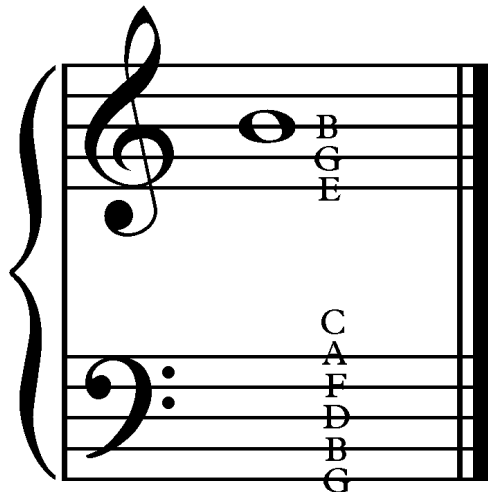
On the Grand Staff below, draw the eleven line notes. Then fill in the letter names of the notes using skips in the alphabet starting with G.

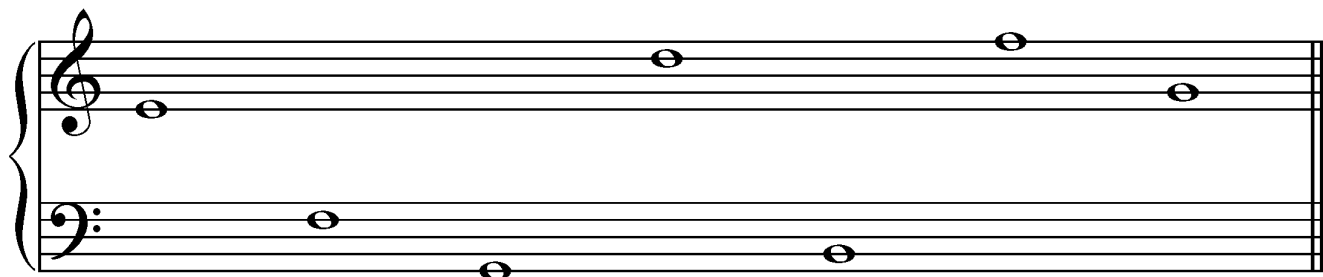
How to Name a Line Note

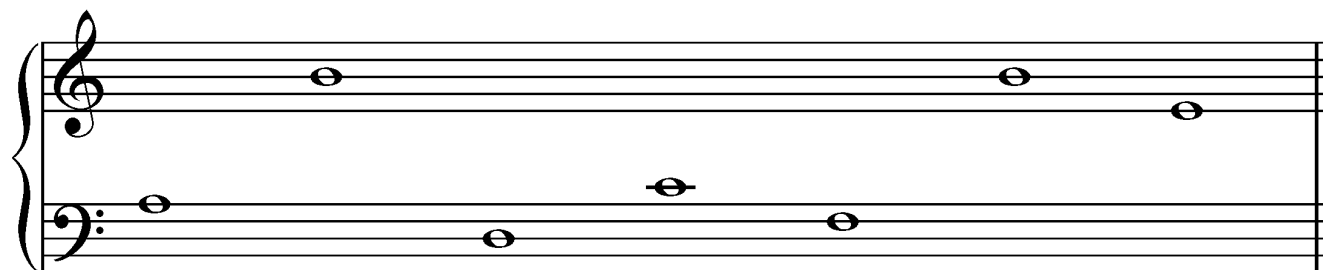


When naming line notes on the Grand Staff, name skips in the alphabet starting on G.

Write the letter name of each note.

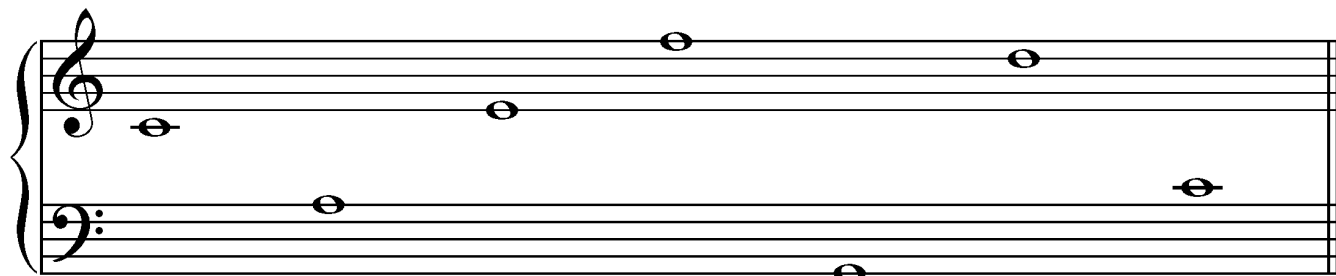


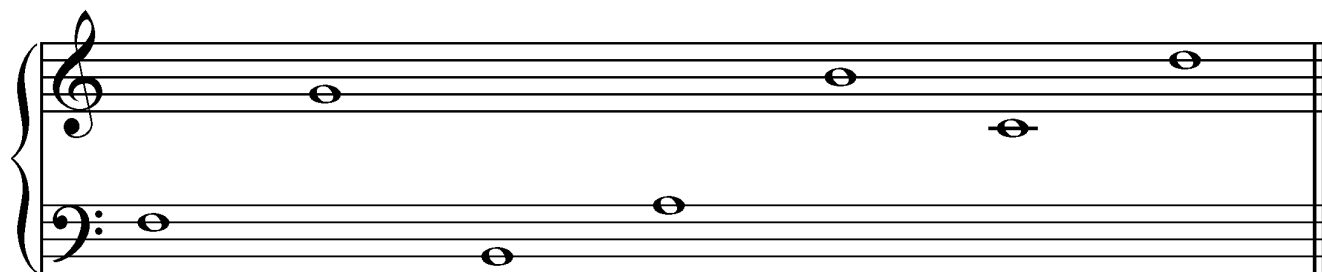


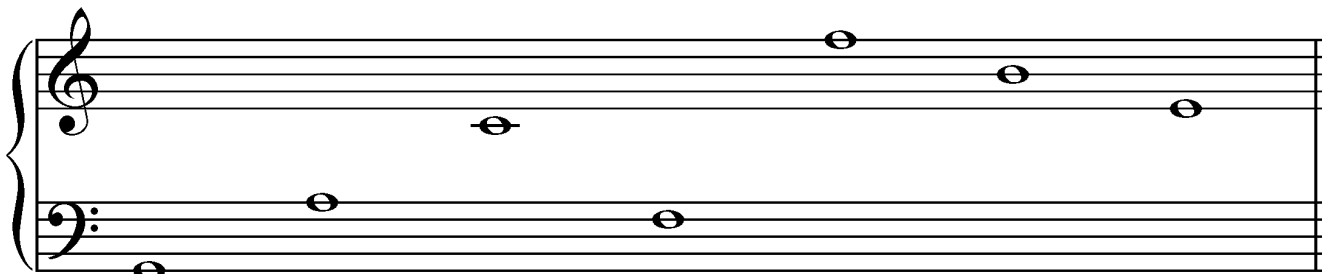
