In 2023, we planted 11 raised vegetable beds on 19th and Tennessee Avenue in Niagara Falls, NY that provided much needed food for our underserved residents. Today, we continue to receive calls of appreciation regarding how the vegetables helped families throughout the winter.

In addition to our gardens, Niagara United Vision, Inc. presented \$16,000.00 in need-based scholarships to students attending college for the first time. Each of the students currently are maintaining a 3.50 GPA or higher. We also received our first \$2,000.00 scholarship sponsorship from Bishop and Pastor Scott of the Word of Life Ministries in Niagara Falls, New York.
