Prov 14:8	The wisdom of the עָרוֹם is to understand his way	“For <i>God doth know</i> that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and <i>ye shall be as gods</i> , knowing good and evil.” Gen 3:5
Prov 12:23	A עָרוֹם man concealeth knowledge	“But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it...” Gen 2:17
Prov 22:3, 7:12	A עָרוֹם man foreseeth evil	“...for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.” Gen 2:17
Prov 12:16	a עָרוֹם man covereth shame	Unto Adam also and to his wife did the Lord God make coats of skins, and clothed them. Gen 3:21

God is plural. God is עָרוֹם. The serpent is עָרוֹם. *The serpent is God.*

## Becoming עָרוֹם. Becoming like gods.

14:8	The wisdom of the עָרוֹם is to understand his way	And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise... Gen 3:6
13:16	<i>Every</i> עָרוֹם man (plural) dealeth with knowledge	...she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. Gen 3:6
22:3, 27:12	A עָרוֹם man foreseeth evil	And [Adam] said, “I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked...” Gen 3:10
12:23	A עָרוֹם man concealeth knowledge	“...and I hid myself.” Gen 3:10
12:16	a עָרוֹם man covereth shame	And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. Gen 3:7

Except...look carefully...what did both god and the serpent say, *exactly*, about eating the fruit?

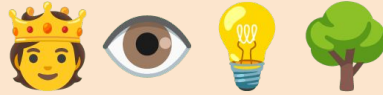
