LC#1: Clip 1	On the leaf, the adjacent cells let plant materials move between cells.	adjacent	What does adjacent mean?	next to or near something
LC#1: Clip 2	Mr. Mulvihill was oblivious to the thunder storm and continued his work on the roof of the garage.	oblivious	What does oblivious mean?	not noticing or paying attention to something
LC#1: Clip 3	The events in the article are listed in chronological order so be sure to answer in the same way.	chronological	What does chronological mean?	the order that things happened
LC#1: Clip 4	The due date of this assignment is tentative so keep that in mind.	tentative	What does tentative mean?	uncertain or not definite
LC#1: Clip 5	Listen up everyone. It was a unanimous decision to have a picnic for our end of the year party.	unanimous	What does unanimous mean?	all the people in a group or class vote for the same thing, everyone agrees
LC#1: Clip 6	For number 3, you need to find and explain the origins of the word "mathematics."	origins	What does origins mean?	refers to where something comes from, where it started or began, the origins of a word tell us where the word comes from and how it was created
LC#1: Clip 7	To make sure their plants had the water they needed to grow, the farmers use an irrigation system.	irrigation	What does irrigation mean?	the process of using water to help plants grow, a hose or a special system of pipes to bring water to the plants
LC#1: Clip 8	So yesterday we talked about the recent wildfire that engulfed the area north of us. Who can tell me where that was?	engulf	What does engulf mean?	to completely surround or cover something
LC#1: Clip 9	I'm worried that new text book is just too unwieldy for you to carry around.	unwieldy	What does unwieldy mean?	something that is difficult to handle or control because it is too big, too heavy, or too complicated
LC#1: Clip 10	Raise your hand if you think that sentence contradicts what we read in the article.	contradict	What does contradict mean?	to say or do something that is opposite or goes against something that someone else has said or done
