

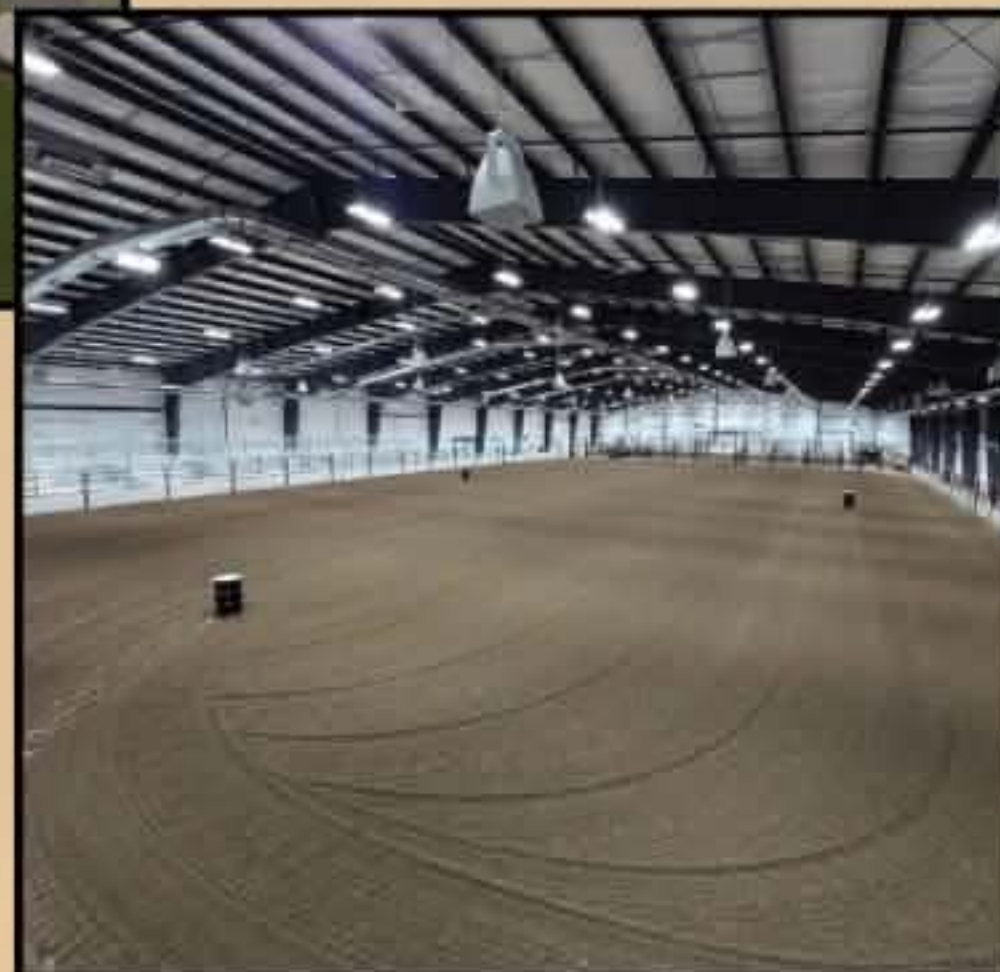

All horse papers, APHA cards and APHC cards can also be uploaded directly onto the form. Failure to submit a complete Master Entry (form, papers and cards) will invoke the late fee.

Class Entries/changes can be made at the show. Our show secretary has requested that you complete your Class Entries on the Master Entry Form in advance of the show. **Make sure to indicate at least one class on your online form.** This will help her set up the classes in advance of the show. Please help her do her job as efficiently as possible.

Please notify gate-person of scratches.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the gate person and show secretary are aware of any classes added or scratched!

You will pay for your entries at the show using cash, cheque or etransfer. Please do not submit payment for entries prior to show.

If there are less than 3 entries per class it is the show management's discretion to combine the class.

Show Fees

All-Inclusive Flat Fee for APHC members only:
\$465/horse

Exhibitors choosing to pay the All-Inclusive Flat Fee are eligible to show in any class, any division with any rider on that particular horse. Signature Series and CCF Class fees are not included in the All-Inclusive Flat Fee.

Office Fee

\$50/horse

APHA Processing/PAYnt Points \$18/class

Includes APHA Show Processing (\$1.50 per class/judge) and PAYnt Points (\$3 per class/judge) fees. Entry into any APHA classes will incur this additional fee.

Individual Class Entry Fee:

\$125/class

Youth Walk Trot & Leadline Entry Fees: Youth Walk-Trot competitors only have to pay a \$50 office fee. Class entries are **FREE**.

Youth Leadline (not an APHA class) class entries are **FREE**. Leadline competitors must wear a helmet when showing **and accompanied by an adult**.

Trail Warmup

\$10/horse if entered in trail

Drug Testing fee - \$5/horse

2 yr old Western Pleasure

Open Western Pleasure (3 yr old and up)

Open to AQHA, APHA, and APHC horses.

No nomination required but horse owner must be APHC member before entry considered received.

\$500 added money to each futurity (subject to sponsorship). Entry fee is \$125 and \$100 of entry fee goes into purse. Rules are the exhibitor's responsibility to read and can be found on APHC website. Fee is non-refundable until a vet certificate is received.

CCF entries are to be completed on a different form than our master entry form. Please ensure you check the CCF portion of the APHC webpage for rules and details.

Stabling - \$180/stall (includes Thurs - Sat. night)

Camping – \$40/night w/power, \$20/night dry camp

Shavings – \$8.00/bag, 2 bags in stall upon arrival, please indicate on stall form additional bags. More shavings are available, order through front desk.

Stalls, camping and shavings are not considered booked until form AND e-transfer/cheque has been received. The stall manager will assign BOTH stabling and camping spots.

Stalls and camping are not refundable, however, special consideration may be given by the Board of Directors with proof of a vet or medical certificate.

Haul-ins are \$50/horse.

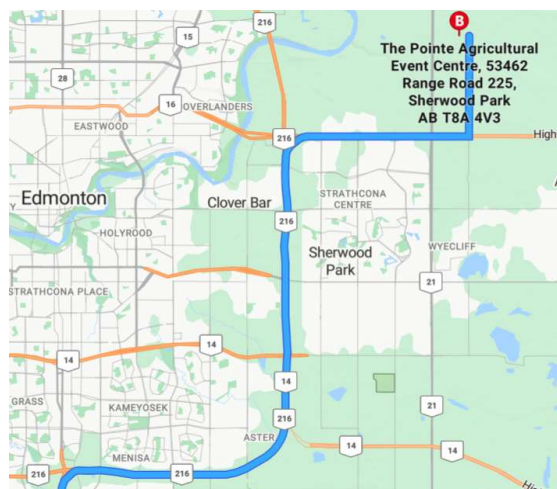
The APHC, its Board of Directors, organizers, and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any injury or death of person(s), or animal(s) or damage to property during this event. All owners and exhibitors stable, exhibit, and enter the show grounds at their own risk. All spectators also enter the show grounds at their own risk.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times and cannot enter the show/warmup areas and stands.



Welcome Exhibitors! This is the first year in many that we've changed one of our show venues and along with that comes slightly different arrangements that everyone should be aware of.

The Pointe Agricultural Center is located in the Strathcona County and is a premier event facility. Access is relatively straight forward.



Some additional info:

- please complete the waiver form included in the show bill package as the facility needs one from each exhibitor
- no outside shavings permitted, additional shavings can be purchased from the front desk between 9:00 am and 7:00 PM
- when applying hoof black, please place something under so the hoof black does not mark the floor (cardboard could be available in the barn)
- no alcohol permitted in the barn or show area
- the Looma Light Horse Club will be on site Sunday afternoon to clean out horse stalls, please leave your tack stall tidy and dispose of any garbage
- dogs are permitted in the barn area only and must be on a leash. Your dog/your responsibility.
- there is no food concession but there are the usual fast food places 10-15 minutes away in Sherwood Park. Also, one could check with Skip the Dishes/Door Dash and perhaps if there's a group ordering, it might be worth it to try this option.

This is a new adventure for all of us so please be patient and understanding while enjoying the APHC Fall Classic Show.
