RULES & DETAILS

- 1. Please complete the Master Entry form by midnight, July 24, 2022 for each horse. A complete entry includes all registration papers, current APHA cards, and current year APHC cards. These can be uploaded directly online via the online entry form.
- 2. Incomplete entries received after July 24, 2022 will be charged a late fee.
- 3. Payments for entries must be made at the show cash or cheque made out to "APHC" only. Class entries and changes can be made at the show. For help with entries, please contact Kathie MacKenzie (403) 804-4031 or abpaintshow@gmail.com.
- 4. All-Inclusive (\$500) and Class Fees (\$125) include an office fee. The All-Inclusive Flat Fee is for one horse, to be shown in any class, any division, with any rider. Stalls, Futurity entries, Jackpot entries, or trail warm-up fees are not included in the All-Inclusive fee. Horses not showing in APHA classes but showing in futurities must pay a one-time \$50 office fee.
- Stall will be located in Tents A,B,C, and D. Stalls booked after July 24, 2022 will be charged a late fee. Stall submission and payments must be received the same day. Payments can be made online by sending e-transfer to aphctreasurer@gmail.com or mailed cheque to Zone 10 % Tessy Rupert, Box 511, Carbon AB, TOM OLO. Please make cheques payable to "APHC".
- 6. Entries, stalls, and camping are non-refundable without a veterinarian or medical certificate.
- RV Reservations must be submitted to Zone 10 and will be assigned. Payments must be made directly to Westerner Park Campground upon arrival to avoid tickets issued by the City of Red Deer.
- Early arrivals not permitted before 6pm, August 3. There will be no access to the Sand or Main arena. If you are using the facility before midnight August 3, you are doing so at your own risk. Westerner Park, Zone 10 Committee, and APHC assume no liability.
- 9. Please notify the show office of any scratches or adds well in advance of the class.
- 10. If there are less than three entries in a class, the class may be combined at the show management's discretion.
- 11. All Paint Registries Classes (APR): All individual working events (per Rule SC-185.F) may be offered as an all Paint registries class. Classes marked with an (*) in the show bill will, at the discretion of show management, be run concurrently. APHA points will be awarded based on the number of horses competing in each registry type.
- 12. Performance Halter: Horses must compete in at least one performance class (other than Showmanship) at the same show.

- 13. Supreme Halter Horse: Any Grand from any Judge from all halter classes are asked to return to the arena for the decision of the Supreme Halter Horse of show. The judges will unanimously choose one Supreme winner.
- 14. Payouts for all Jackpots/Futurities/Challenge will be made out by mailed cheque following the show.
- Yearling Challenge classes C Halter class run on its own. Longe Line / In Hand Trail scores taken from regular open APHA classes
 - a. Halter Class 1001: Will run as its own class.
 - b. In Hand Trail Class 1011: This class will run concurrently with APHA In Hand Trail classes 400 and 401. Non-APHA horses will also show concurrently.
 - c. Longe Line Class 1021: This class will run concurrently with APHA Longe Line classes 275 and 280. Non-APHA horses will also show concurrently.
- 16. APHA Jackpot classes: Mark by a 💰 in the class list. The highest placing exhibitor, across all judges, who paid into the jackpot; Paid to first only. Entries must be made at the show office and paid by cash only. Entries must be received by 6pm the night before the class. Winnings will be distributed separately.
- 17. Youth Leadline (non-APHA) class entries are free. Leadline competitors must wear a helmet when showing.
- All Ages Jackpots: Open to any NSBA type horse. Horse owners must be a current year APHC or SPHC member. To be eligible for applicable non-pro awards, the association's Amateur or Youth card must be included with entries. 100% of monies paid out. Payouts will be based on the following schedule:
