Memorial regulations &
application form

We are able to offer the provision of a means of commemorating the place where families have had the cremated remains of their loved ones interred.

The requirement is to have a tablet of York Stone, properly embedded, flush with the surrounding ground at the place of the internment and of a uniform size of 12 inches by 8 inches.

These table may have the following inscription:

- the Christian name(s) and surname of the deceased
- an indication of either their dates of birth and death, or of their age.

A condition of the granting of this facility is that no other form of identification or memorial or fencing or artificial grass is allowed.

In order to ensure these regulations are adhered to, the only person allowed to **provide and install** the tablet is G.B. Newell of Nine Lands Lane, Garforth, Leeds, LS25 INT. Tel: 0113 287 2356.

Applications for the introduction of a tablet must be made ont the form attached and submitted to the church.

Upon approval, the application cane be taken to Newells for the work to proceed.
