Ordained Deacon - but what does that mean?

When someone has completed their initial college training they are ordained deacon by the bishop and start their curacy for 3/4 years: putting into practice what's been learned in training in order to prepare for their own ministry. Deacons do a variety of things, but have to be ordained priest before they can preside over Holy Communion. Most people are ordained priest after a year of curacy, although some decide to stay deacons. You can spot a deacon because they wear their stole diagonally.


