They can be taken orally or used topically, depending on the herb and intended use. Some examples of herbal powders include turmeric powder, neem powder, ashwagandha powder, and amla powder.

MANUFACTURING PROCESS

Herbal powders are typically produced through a process called drying and milling. The process begins with the selection of high-quality, fresh herbs that are free from contaminants and diseases. The herbs are then washed and cleaned to remove dirt and debris. Next, the herbs are dried using a variety of methods such as sun drying, shade drying, or using a dehydrator. The drying process removes the moisture from the herbs, preserving the active compounds and preventing spoilage.

Once the herbs are dry, they are then milled into a fine powder using a grinder or mill. The milling process breaks down the dried herbs into small particles, making it easier to consume and mix with other ingredients.

Finally, the powder is sifted to remove any large pieces and to ensure a consistent particle size. After that, it is packaged and stored in an airtight container to maintain its freshness.

Spray dried powders are small particles of a substance that are formed by atomizing a liquid into fine droplets and then drying them in a hot air stream. The process results in a dry, free-flowing powder that can be easily reconstituted into its original form by adding water.


ADVANTAGE

- 4.) Customizable particle size and surface area for desired properties


