

6: THE CROSS - THE CHAMPION LIFE CONQUERORS & VICTORIOUS WITNESSES

Start with> Profess confidently the Champion Life Blessing: I am Deeply Blessed, Highly Favored, Unconditional Loved, and Filled with a Divine Purpose. You are a CHAMPION IN CHRIST. Take a moment and just look out and declare the Goodness, Awesomeness and Love of Abba God.

1 CORINTHIANS 15:57-58 (TPT)

“But we thank God for giving us the victory as conquerors through our Lord Jesus, the Anointed One. So now, beloved ones, stand firm, stable, and enduring. Live your lives with an unshakable confidence. We know that we prosper and excel in every season by serving the Lord, because we are assured that our union with the Lord makes our labor productive with fruit that endures.”

REVELATION 12:10-11 (NLT)

“Then I heard a loud voice shouting across the heavens, “It has come at last— salvation and power and the Kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers and sisters has been thrown down to earth— the one who accuses them before our God day and night. And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.”

ACTS 1:8 (NLT)

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read John 3:16 (The Father’s so Loved the World)
2. Commit to living a life that is an example of the Love of God, to love others, to be His Disciple and Share the Good News of Jesus to all I come in contact with. (Read and Pray Matthew 28:18-20)
3. God’s perspective from up on top of the hill. Ask for a Heart that ALL people would know God. Realize that God sees and knows everything and every step of your life. He calls you Child of God because Jesus is your Savior. NOTHING IS TOO DIFFICULT FOR HIM.
4. Sit and Look at the cars go by on the road. Inside each vehicle is a precious human being that God so loves...because He loves the whole world and at the same time, he knows the number of hairs on your head. Pray that your love for others will inspire you to go tell the world and live the Champion Life...



1: HELLO FATHER PEACE AND PRESENCE

Start with> Take a deep breath in! Exhale out! Say, “Hello Abba Father. Thank You for loving me. In this time today, reveal your unconditional love and grace to me and may I encounter the presence and peace of the Holy Spirit.”

PSALMS 16:11 (NKJV)

“You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.”

MATTHEW 6:9 (NLT)

“Pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy.”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read Psalm 23 (The Father’s Guidance)
2. Declare the Names of God and I am statements of Jesus
3. Reflect on the Fathers love for you just as you are and realizing that He loves you enough to want you live a life pleasing to him.

2: PRAISE YOUR NAME THANKSGIVING & PRAISE

Start with> saying, I Thank you, Father for this day you have given me. I’m thankful for “_____” in my life. Help me see that you are the Source and Strength of my life. I Thank you for what you have done for me. I Praise you because you are a loving, compassionate, merciful and forgiving God. I Praise you for who you are: You are my Savior, Lord, Provider, Healer, and You never leave nor forsake me.

PSALMS 150:1-2, 6 (NLT)

“Praise the Lord! Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heaven! Praise him for his mighty works; praise his unequalled greatness! Let everything that breathes sing praises to the Lord! Praise the Lord!”

1 THESSALONIANS 5:16-18 (NLT)

“Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God’s will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read Psalm 100 (The Father’s Joy)
2. Sing a Worship song to the Father God (Refer to Guide in Prayer Room)
3. Declare over yourself the “I am in Christ statements” (Refer to Guide in Prayer Room)



3: SEEK YOUR KINGDOM

SEEK & SERVE

Start with> saying, I make a commitment to keep You first place in my life. Give me strength to follow through. I desire to obey you as a Child of God and as a disciple of Christ. I will serve you with all my heart, soul, and mind knowing that your love never fails or stops toward me. I choose to fulfill my purpose in the Kingdom of God and my part to serve you at my local church.

MATTHEW 6:33-34 (NLT)

“Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. “So don’t worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today’s trouble is enough for today.”

ROMANS 8:31, 37-39 (NIV)

“What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read Psalm 63 (The Father’s Love)
2. Declare boldness to serve in the Kingdom of God and share the Good News: to be a disciple of Jesus and a disciple maker of Jesus (Read Matthew 28:18-20).
3. Speak, say, and pray The Word of God over all areas and circumstances of your life, there is power in praying God’s Word. (Read and Pray Philipians 4:6-7)

4: ASK IN FAITH

BELIEVE & RECEIVE

Start with> saying, Father, you love me and care for me, so I come to you and ask you to meet my needs and this request in Jesus name. I trust in your Word to answer these needs according to your Will and Plan for my life.

MATTHEW 7:7-8 (NLT)

“Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.”

PHILIPPIANS 4:19 (TPT)

“I am convinced that my God will fully satisfy every need you have, for I have seen the abundant riches of glory revealed to me through Jesus Christ!”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read Psalm 91 (The Father’s Protection)
2. Give God praise and thanks as you Ask the Holy Spirit to speak a Bible verse to your heart that gives you the assurance as you believe that by Faith the answer to your request is in motion (Read and Pray Matthew 21:21-22)
3. Read James 5:13-18 - The Power and Why Pray

5: LISTEN TO THE SPIRIT SPEAK

SILENCE & STILLNESS

Start with> Take a bold moment and Turn off your cell phone for this time with God to eliminate distractions so you can listen to the Holy Spirit free from technology. Take a few deep breaths in and out. Close your eyes and sit still. Ask Holy Spirit to speak a word to your heart. BE STILL AND LISTEN. After a few minutes Look up the hill and focus on The Cross- and Reflect on the Love, Sacrifice, Jesus, Forgiveness and Freedom that has been purchased for you.

PSALM 46:10 (ESV)

“Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!”

PSALM 46:10 (TPT)

“Surrender your anxiety. Be still and realize that I am God. I am God above all the nations, and I am exalted throughout the whole earth.”

ROMANS 8:14-17 (NLT)

“For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God’s Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, “Abba, Father.” For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God’s children. And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God’s glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering (persecution).”

REFLECTION TIME:

1. Read Psalm 46 (The Father’s Peace)
2. Write down the Word the Holy Spirit speaks to you so you can read and look at it daily to persuade your heart that your Father God is moving and at work.
3. GOING DEEPER: Power of Forgiveness: Receive and accept forgiveness from Father God for yourself and if need be, Forgive others and/or make a decision to ask someone to forgive you. Do not allow unforgiveness to halt your growth in Christ. (Read and Pray Ephesians 4:32 and Colossians 3:13)
