

## Reflective Questions for the Gospel of Mark

### 1. Knowing Jesus — His Identity (Mark 1–4)

1. Who do I believe Jesus is, and how does my life demonstrate that belief? (Mark 1:1; 1:24; 4:41)
  2. What areas of my life need to come under Jesus' authority today?
  3. How do I respond when Jesus calls me to leave something behind to follow Him? (1:16–20)
  4. Which "soil" best describes my heart right now? (4:3–20)
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### 2. Experiencing His Power — Faith & Dependence (Mark 5–8)

5. What fear or crisis am I currently bringing to Jesus in faith? (5:22–34)
  6. Where have I seen Jesus provide when I trusted Him with little? (6:34–44; 8:1–9)
  7. What spiritual blindness might still be limiting my understanding of Jesus? (8:17–21)
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### 3. Following the Way of the Cross — Discipleship (Mark 8–10)

8. What does "deny yourself" look like in my daily walk? (8:34–35)
  9. What distractions or attachments could be hindering my full obedience? (10:17–22)
  10. How am I serving others instead of seeking status? (10:42–45)
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### 4. Recognizing the King — Worship & Watchfulness (Mark 11–13)

11. What expectations do I place on Jesus that He may be challenging or correcting? (11:1–10)
  12. Are there areas of my worship that have become routine rather than sincere? (11:15–17)
  13. How does Jesus' teaching about the future shape the way I live today? (13:32–37)
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### 5. Trusting Him Completely — Suffering, Death & Resurrection (Mark 14–16)

14. When tested, do I remain faithful or retreat in fear? (14:27–31, 66–72)
  15. What does Jesus' sacrifice mean for the way I view suffering and obedience? (15:16–39)
  16. How does the resurrection give me courage to live boldly for Christ? (16:1–8)
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### Personal Response & Application

17. What is the Holy Spirit inviting me to surrender after reading Mark's Gospel?
18. What step of obedience will I take this week because of what I've learned about Jesus?
19. How can I more clearly reflect Christ's compassion and authority in my daily life?
20. Who needs to hear the "good news" through my words and actions this week? (16:15)
