- ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted
- REQUIRED - Copy of negative Coggins within 1 year of show date and Flu/Rhino within 6 months of show date (can be emailed ahead of time to kcsequinellc@gmail.com)
- Divisions will be split or combined as entries warrant
- Ribbons 1-6 in each class
- Grand and Reserve Champion in each division
- Decision of the judge/organizer will be final
- Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/24
- Other Divisions/Classes are divisions/classes that are not recognized by PHSA
- All Divisions eligible for KCS year end awards
- Formal Attire Not Required

T.I.P Eligibility

- For purposes of eligibility for all T.I.P. classes and awards, a "Thoroughbred" is defined as any horse that has been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book approved by The Jockey Club and the International Stud Book Committee.
- REQUIRED to provide horse's registered name, show name, rider name and T.I.P. Number OR completed T.I.P. Number request form

PHSA Divisions

Developing Hunter - (x-rails or 2') Open to horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing, ridden by juniors, adults or professionals. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability.

Baby Green - (2'6") Open to horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing, ridden by juniors, adults or professionals. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability.

Thoroughbred Hunter - (x-rails, 2' or 2'6") Open to all riders and Thoroughbreds with T.I.P. Numbers or proof of registration with the Jockey Club. (Numbers can be obtained for free on www.tjctip.com). Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability.

Leadline - Open to children 7 years and younger. May not cross enter into other divisions.

Mini Stirrup - Open to children who are not ready to canter at horse shows. May only cross enter into other walk/trot classes or divisions at the same show.

Short Stirrup - (x-rails) Open to children 12 years & under. To be judged on equitation. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'. This division is meant for children who are not ready to move up to Pre-Children's Pony or other similar divisions.

Short Stirrup Hunter - (18') Open to children 12 years & under. To be judged on soundness, manners, suitability and way of going. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'. This division is meant for children we are not ready to move up to Pre-Children's Pony or other similar divisions.

Pleasure Pony - (x-rails to 2') Open to ponies. To be judged on manners, suitability, and soundness. Open to juniors and adults.

Pleasure Horse - (2' or 2'6") Open to all horses. To be judged on manners, suitability, and soundness. Open to juniors and adults.

Hopeful Hunter - (2', 2'6" or 2'9") Open to all horses and ponies to be ridden by juniors, adults, or professionals. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability.

PHSA Divisions (cont'd)

Pre-Children's Pony Hunter - (2') Open to all ponies, to be ridden by juniors. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Pony/rider combination may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Pony.

Children's Pony Hunter - (2'3" to 2'6") Open to all ponies to be ridden by juniors. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Pony/rider combination may not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter Pony.

Pre-Children's Hunter Horse - (2'6") Open to all horses to be ridden by juniors. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Children's Hunter Horse.

Pre-Adult Hunter Horse - (2'6") Open to all horses to be ridden by adults. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Adult Hunter Horse.

Children's Hunter Horse - (3') Open to all horses to be ridden by juniors. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Horse/rider may not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter Horse.

Adult Hunter Horse - (3') Open to adult amateur riders. Judged on soundness, manners, way of going and suitability. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter or Pre-Adult Hunter.

Jumpers 0.85 & Lower - Open to all ponies, horses and riders. Fences up to .85 meter height

Jumpers 0.90 & Higher - Open to all ponies, horses and riders

Other Divisions/Classes

Open Equitation - (x-rails or 2') Open to riders of any age and have not shown over 2'

Long Stirrup - (x-rails) Open to riders 13 years and older.

Mini Medal - (x-rails) Open to all riders. May not enter a division to jump higher than x-rails.

KCS Medal - (2' or 2'3") Open to all riders. May not enter a division to jump higher than 2'3".

High Flying Medal - (2'6" or 3') Open to all riders. May not enter a division to jump higher than 3'.

Gambler's Choice - (0.85 meter & lower) Open to all riders/horses. Runs with corresponding height as open card.

Gambler's Choice - (0.9 meter & higher) Open to all riders/horses. Runs with corresponding height as open card.

T.I.P. Jumper Classic - (x-rails to 1 meter) Open to horses that competed in at least one Jumper class are eligible to compete in The Jockey Club T.I.P. Jumper Classic.

Hunter High Point T.I.P. - Given to the Hunter Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Hunter classes.

Jumper High Point T.I.P. - Given to the Jumper Thoroughbred at the horse show accumulating the most points toward the award in Jumper classes.
