Academic Integrity and Anti Plagiarism Policy

1. Introduction

Passion Education Ltd is a high seniority academic institution dedicated to securing each student's academic trajectory through the **APEX Framework**. Intellectual honesty is the foundation of our **Surgical Writing Labs** and live tuition model. This policy outlines our expectations for original scholarship and the procedures for addressing forensic failure points in academic conduct.

2. Definitions

- **Plagiarism:** The act of presenting another person's work, ideas, or prose as one's own without proper acknowledgement.
- **Collusion:** Unauthorised collaboration between students or with external parties on assignments intended for individual submission.
- **Artificial Intelligence Misuse:** The unauthorised use of generative AI tools to produce essays, mathematical solutions, or scientific reports.
- **Contract Cheating:** Engaging third party services or "essay mills" to complete academic work.

3. Student Responsibilities

- Students must ensure that every piece of work submitted for **100% live tuition** is their own original creation.
- Students are expected to maintain the high seniority standards of the institution by citing all external sources used in their research.
- Learners must participate honestly in **Surgical Writing Labs**, as the "real time surgery" performed by staff requires an authentic baseline of the student's current ability.

4. Forensic Detection and Monitoring

As a high seniority institution, we do not rely solely on automated software. Our staff are trained in **forensic assessment** to identify inconsistencies in a student's linguistic trajectory. Detection methods include:

- **Linguistic Audit:** Identifying shifts in vocabulary or syntax that do not align with the student's established academic profile.
- **Oral Defense:** During live sessions, students may be asked to explain the logic, structural choices, or specific terminology used in their submitted work.
- **Comparative Analysis:** Cross referencing current submissions with previous classroom performance to monitor growth and authenticity.

5. Procedures for Breach of Integrity

If a staff member identifies a forensic failure point related to academic integrity, the following steps will be taken:

1. **Initial Inquiry:** The teacher will discuss the work with the student during the live session to determine the origin of the prose.
2. **Surgical Audit:** If concerns remain, the work will undergo a formal audit by the **COO** or **CEO**.
3. **Parental Notification:** Parents will be informed of the breach as part of our commitment to **support with learning at home**.

6. Sanctions

- Requirement to resubmit the assignment under supervised live conditions.
- A formal warning recorded on the student's academic record.
