Admissions and Academic Trajectory Assessment Procedure

1. Introduction

The admissions process at Passion Education Ltd is designed to identify a student's current academic position and potential for growth within the **APEX Framework**. We do not admit students based on arbitrary criteria but through a **forensic assessment** of their ability to engage with **high seniority** academic instruction.

2. The Diagnostic Phase

Every prospective student must undergo a diagnostic assessment before enrolment is confirmed.

- **Forensic Audit:** The student will complete a proprietary assessment task designed to reveal **forensic failure points** in their current understanding.
- **Prose and Logic Analysis:** For humanities and STEM subjects alike, we analyse the student's ability to execute complex tasks under timed or supervised conditions.
- **Initial Trajectory Report:** Following the assessment, the **CEO** or **COO** will provide a summary of the child's current **academic trajectory** and the steps required to reach mastery.

3. Seniority Consultation

Following the diagnostic phase, a consultation may be held between the **high seniority** staff and the parents.

- **Placement Recommendations:** We advise on the most suitable **iGCSE bundles** or **11 plus** booster camps based on the diagnostic data.
- **Commitment Review:** Parents are briefed on the **Homework and Academic Extension Policy** to ensure they can provide the necessary **support with learning at home**.

4. Enrolment Criteria

Admission to Passion Education Ltd is at the sole discretion of the **CEO**. We seek students who:

- Demonstrate a willingness to engage in **100% live tuition**.

- Are committed to the rigour of the **Surgical Writing Labs** and the **APEX Framework**.

5. Cell Formation and Viability (Terms and Conditions of Enrolment)
