Online Safety and Acceptable Use Policy

1. Introduction

Passion Education Ltd operates exclusively within a digital landscape to provide elite alternative provision. This policy defines the standards of behaviour and technical safety required to protect the integrity of the **APEX Framework** and the wellbeing of all participants. All students, parents, and staff are bound by these terms upon enrolment.

2. Technical Integrity and Security

- **Instructional Cell Access:** Entry into the Academy's Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) is strictly contingent upon the **Cell Viability** mandate. Access credentials are only issued once an **Instructional Cell** has reached the **Minimum Density of 5 scholars** and the cell is moved from **Pending** to **Active Status**.
- **Authorised Access:** Students must only access live sessions through the official secure links provided by the Academy. Sharing access credentials with external parties is a severe breach of security.
- **Hardware and Environment:** To maintain the high seniority of the session, students should join from a stable device with a functioning camera and microphone. The background should be neutral and professional.
- **Malicious Software:** The intentional upload of files containing viruses or the use of software designed to disrupt the digital classroom is strictly prohibited.

3. Acceptable Use for Students

- **Professional Prose & Linguistic Auditing:** To maintain the high seniority of our labs, all digital communication must adhere to the **Surgical Writing** standards. Scholars must use formal **British English** in all text based interactions. The use of informal shorthand, slang, or non academic icons is a breach of the **Architecture of Logic** we cultivate.
- **Focus and Discipline:** During live tuition, students must not engage in "multi tasking" or access unrelated websites, social media, or gaming platforms.
- **Privacy of Peers:** Recording, photographing, or taking "screen shots" of other students or staff members during a session is strictly forbidden.

4. Digital Conduct and Cyberbullying

- **Respectful Discourse:** The **8 Max class size** relies on a culture of mutual academic respect. Any form of digital harassment, discriminatory language, or "trolling" will result in immediate removal from the session.
- **Reporting Misconduct:** Any student who feels uncomfortable or witnesses inappropriate behaviour online must report it to the high seniority instructor or the CEO immediately.

5. Parental Oversight

While we encourage student independence, parents are responsible for the following:

- **Supervision:** Ensuring that the student's internet filters are appropriate for an academic setting.
- **Support with Learning at Home:** Monitoring the student's digital footprint to ensure it aligns with the values of Passion Education Ltd.

6. Monitoring and Enforcement

- **Sanctions and Liability:** The Academy reserves the right to monitor all activity within its proprietary digital platforms. Breaches of this policy may result in a formal warning, temporary suspension, or permanent expulsion.
- **Financial Continuity:** If a scholar is permanently expelled for a severe breach of digital conduct, the Academy is under no obligation to issue a refund. This protects the **Operational Liquidity** of the cell and ensures the **Senior Practitioner** remains remunerated for the cohort.
- **Legal Compliance:** Where digital conduct involves criminal activity, Passion Education Ltd will cooperate fully with the relevant UK authorities.
