AFFIDAVIT-IN-OPPOSITION OF THE RESPONDENT NO.6

1. I, Sri Biman Bandyopadhyay son of late Ambica Charan Bandyopadhyay, aged about 48 years, working for gain at Bengal Engineering And science University, Shibpur, Howrah-711103, do hereby solemnly affirm and say as follows:

2. That I am the Registrar of the Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur (hereinafter referred to as BESU), Respondent No.6 and as such well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the instant case. I am affirming this on my behalf and am competent to do the same.

3. I have gone through a copy of the application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India (hereinafter referred to as the said Petition) which was affirmed on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2008 affirmed by one Shri Manas Hira. The said Petition contains many incorrect averments and save what are borne out of records and save what are specifically admitted hereunder I deny all other allegations made in the said Petition as of the some are set out and traversed in seriatim.

4. I have been advised to deal with only those allegations which are material for the purpose of proper adjudication of the list and any nonspecific denial with regard to any allegation/statement made in the said Petition shall not be construed as admission on my part. Save as would appear

from the admitted records and save as expressly admitted by me hereafter I deny each and all the allegations contained in the said Petition as if same are set out and traversed.

4A. Before dealing with the allegations contained in the said Petition I respectfully submit in the manner as follows:-

(a) That the said application at the outset fails to make any prima facie case for warranting judicial interdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Quo-Warranto. The Writ Petition does not disclose as to whether the Respondent No.2 is at all duly authorized by its members to affirm this writ Petition by virtue of any resolution passed in a general body meeting for ventilating their fictitious grievance before this Hon'ble Court and in absence of such resolution the Writ Petitioner No.2 cannot maintain a Writ Petition thereby representing the Petitioner No.1.

(b) The writ Petition is hopelessly misconceived, frivolous, and barred by unexplained unreasonable delay.

© On being acquainted/informed with regard to the publication of an advertisement made by the Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur, Howrah I have submitted an application addressed to the

Registrar, BESU for consideration my candidature to the post in question 16.07.2007 along with bio-data and testimonials. Photo copies of the application and other documents are annexed hereto and marked collectively marked with the letter 'R-1'

(d) I was aware of the advertisement bearing No.R/16/2004 published in the University Website as well as in the vernacular Newspaper seeking recruitment to the post of Registrar, BESU in the year 2004. I had also noticed an advertisement being advertisement No.RA 7607 in May, 2007, pertaining to the post in question. I found that the eligibility condition as laid down in the said advertisement and the earlier advertisement being No.R/16/2004 were exactly the same and further commensurate with my qualifications and experiences which I had. After understanding the contents of eligibility criteria for the post of Registrar mentioned in the advertisement published in May 2007, I applied for the same. Photo copies of both the advertisements are annexed herewith and marked with 'R-2'.

(e) In response to my application, the concerned authority called me for an interview by the Selection Committee on 06.09.07 for selection to the post of Registrar, BESU vide letter No.RRS-4/139(M) dated 10.08.07. Photo copy of the Interview letter is annexed hereto and marked with the letter 'R-3'.

(f) I went to BESU along with all the original certificates and testimonials on 06.09.09 for the interview. I was interviewed quite stringently for a long time by a large Selection Committee consisting of six(6) learned members. There were altogether 8 people including me appearing for the interview before the Selection Committee.

(g) I received an appointment letter to the Post of Registrar (Lien Vacancy) in the BESU vide letter No.RRS-4/Offer/1588 dated 03.12.07. Photo copy of the appointment letter is annexed hereto and marked with the letter 'R-4'.

(h) After receiving the appointment letter I joined the post of Registrar, BESU on 15.01.08 taking formal release on lien for one year from my previous employer, Kolkata Improvement Trust. Photo copies of my joining letter along with the release order and other necessary documents are annexed hereto and marked with the letter 'R-5'.

(i) On 23.09.2008, 8 months 8 days after joining as Registrar, I received a letter on the issue of my appointment to the post of Registrar,

BESU, Shibpur from the learned Advocate Sri Agniswar Dutta Gupta, who sent this letter to me under instruction from his client Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur Teacher's Association (BESUTA).

(j) On 24.09.08 without indicating any reason I submitted my resignation from the post of Registrar, BESU to the Vice Chancellor requesting him to release me from the duty of Registrar on or before 14.01.09. i.e. before expiry of my lien. Photo copy of my application of resignation is annexed hereto and marked with the letter 'R-6'.

(k) On 03.10.08 I received a letter being No.AT/BOM-Emergency (29-09-08) dated 03.10.08 from the Deputy Registrar, BESU stating that the Board of Management of Bengal Engineering and Science University had not accepted my letter of resignation submitted on 24.09.08. The Board of Management further requested me to withdraw the letter of resignation stating that the Board was satisfied with my performance and contribution to the University as Registrar. Copy of the letter is annexed hereto and marked with the letter 'R-7'.

(l) To honour the decision of the Board of Management I withdrew my letter of resignation on 21.10.08. I also submitted an application to my previous employer, KIT, requesting extension of my lien period so as to keep my option open to join KIT where I have served more than 20 years. Photo copies of the withdrawal of my letter of Resignation and application for extension of lien are annexed hereto and collectively marked with the letter 'R-8'.

(m) The Kolkata Improvement Trust vide order No.P-65 dated 05.12.08 granted me extension of lien for a further six months with effect from 15.01.09.

(n) By order No.RDO-2/2554 dated 14.01.09 I was confirmed to the post of Registrar w.e.f. 15.01.08 after satisfactory completion of my probation period. Photo copy of my letter of confirmation is annexed hereto and marked with letter 'R-9'.

(o) After being confirmed in BESU, I had informed KIT of this

confirmation for taking necessary action. Photo copy of the letter is annexed hereto and marked with the letter '**R-10**'.

(p) The Kolkata Improvement Trust vide letter No.P-4 dated 20.4.09 informed me that my extension of lien for six months w.e.f. 15.01.09 was ceased and the post of Valuation Officer, KIT held by me for so long under lien was declared vacant w.e.f. 14.01.09 i.e. from the date of my confirmation and therefore I was formally released for ever from KIT.

(q) Therefore, I joined BESU on 15.01.08, and confirmed on 15.01.09 and thus became permanent employee of BESU working almost 2 years as Registrar, BESUS.

(r) Bengal Engineering College, Shibpur Howrah ( a Demmed University) was reconstituted as Bengal Engineering and Science University, Shibpur reconstituted under the Bengal Engineering and Science University, Act 2004, whose section 1 and Section 53 has come in effect from 2<sup>nd</sup> September, 2004. Its 1<sup>st</sup> Statutes was published on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2007 and has come into force from 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2007. Its first Regulation was published on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2008 and has come into effect from 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2008. Its



First Ordinance was published on 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2008 and has come into effect from 1<sup>st</sup> day October, 2008 and by notification dated 30.12.08 the Court the Executive Council, the Faculty Councils for post graduate and undergraduate studies and the Boards of Studies has come into force. It is also not out of context to mention that on and from the appointed day, the Rules, Regulations and bye-laws of the Bengal Engineering College (a Deemed University) subject to the provisions of Section 53 (5) shall stand repealed with effect from the date of publication of the Act in the official Gazette.

(s) (In fact, I found that the contents of the advertisement being No.R7604 published in BESU Website) was exactly identical to those contained in the earlier advertisement. Being satisfied with the eligibility criteria that are matching with me and accordingly I applied for the same. As candidate I was only concerned with the advertisement and the conditions laid therein and I was only required to respond by submitting an application containing proper disclosure of facts pertaining to me.

(t) The Petitioners feigning ignorance of the facts and/or the contents of the eligibility conditions laid in the previous advertisement; it is

no difficult to presume and/or accept that they posed their ignorance in a deliberate manner only in order to satisfy their hidden agenda. From the notification as published by the University Grant Commission it appears that in order to become eligible for the post in question one has to secure 15 years of administrative experience of which 8 years as Deputy Registrar or an equivalent. It is crystal clear that the same is application for all establishments including the Industrial establishments because the post of Deputy Registrar or equivalent is not confined to educational institution only which prompted me to believe that I was eligible to apply. Even in the First Ordinance of the University where recruitment notification of the Registrar has been clearly stated as comparable experience in industrial establishment. The draft of the First Ordinance was sent to the Government for approval before I joined BESU, even before the date of publication of the advertisement seeking appointments to the post in question. It is pertinent to mention in this connection that the Petitioners seem to be at a loss while attempting to validate their baseless ignorance by trying to make co-relations with different factual matrix being no relevance on the issue./ I submit that one of the criteria as published in the advertisement was a good academic records. In this context I would like to mention that through out my career I got above

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55% marks which is defined as "a good academic record" in the guidelines framed by the University Grant Commission. In the West Bengal Joint Entrance Examination as that was held in 1980 I was ranked amongst 800 in the general candidate list and got admission in the Department of Civil Engineering of the Bengal Engineering College, Shibpur. I had also completed Master Degree with 1<sup>st</sup> Class in the year 1989 and further successfully completed Ph.D (Engineering) from Jadavpur University in the year 2005. I am really surprised as to whether the Secretary of the Organisation who is the Teacher in the University does really poses a Ph.D degree in the relevant subject of his teaching or is armed with excellent academic records. According to my understanding those who are in teaching profession more particularly in respect of a premier Institution like BESU should have been armed with Ph.D degree.

But 55% is 2nd class. Does he boast of having 2nd div in H.S & Engg. (U level).

Totally out of context

(u) It is very surprising to note that the Petitioners have admitted the fact that they were aware of the advertisement published in Ganasakti which means they were also aware of the content of the advertisement and, as such I see no reason as to why they could not challenge the advertisement before the Selection was made. On the contrary they have deliberately chosen to make a calculative attempt to disturb the fulcrum of the administration.

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Such actions on the part of the Writ Petitioners can only be termed as malafide attitude tainted with ulterior motive and it is clear that this particular action does not reflect a proper function of organization but a proper reflection of unhealthy hegemony of certain individuals.

5. Without prejudice to the above but fully relying on the same I now proceed to deal with the statements/allegations contained in the said Petition.

6. Save as would appear from the admitted records I deny each and all the allegations contained in paragraphs 1 to 10 of the said Petition as if the same are set out and traversed ad-seriatim. I categorically deny and dispute that no panel was formed by the Selection Committee for appointment to the post which is incomplete deviation from established norms and practice of direct recruitment to the post. On the contrary, I say that the normal practice and procedure has been constantly followed by the University and there has been no irregularity far less of illegality. The question of giving reasons by the Selection Committee cannot and does not arise and it is for the Committee to decide as to who are to be selected by them.

Legal opinion

7. Save as would appear from admitted records and save as expressly admitted by me hereinafter I deny each and all the allegations contained in paragraphs 11 to 15 of the said Petition.

8. Save as would appear from admitted records and save as save as expressly admitted by me hereinafter I deny each and all the allegations contained in paragraphs 16 to 30 of the said Petition as if same are set out and traversed ad-seriatim. ( I categorically deny and dispute that comparable experience in industrial establishment as mentioned in the advertisement bearing No.R7607 being de hors the applicable bye-laws and the University Grant Commission notification and the Respondent No.6 not having essential qualifications as mentioned in the bye-laws and the University Grant Commission qualification the selection of the Respondent No.6 is bad and void abinitio. ) On the contrary, I submit I have fulfilled the eligibility criteria as laid down in the advertisement in the manner and to the extent as indicated in the earlier paragraphs of the instant affidavit. I further wish to submit in this connection that the aspirants seeking appointments to the post in question did not challenge my selection and as such it is amply clear that the Petitioners have raised some irrelevant pleas before this Hon'ble Court only to abuse the process of the Hon'ble Court. The Selection Committee has its own

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discretion in the matter of selection. The Selection Committee found me fit and suitable for the post in question. The Petitioners are inviting this Hon'ble Court to sit as an Appellate Authority over the judgment of the Selection process and the opinion of the experts and these issues are not justiciable in order to attract the power of judicial review under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. I categorically deny and dispute that I possess a very ordinary and average academic record contrary to the essential qualifications of uniformly good academic record required by the bye-laws for selection and appointment to the post of Registrar. On the contrary, I repeat and reiterate my statements made in the earlier paragraphs in the instant Affidavit. In this connection I crave leave to refer to the qualifications made by the University Grant Commission at the time of hearing, if necessary.

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9. Save as would appear from admitted records and save as expressly admitted by me hereinafter I deny each and all the allegations contained in paragraph 31 to 39 of the said Petition as if same are set out and traversed ad-seriatim. All the statements are not only a reflection of envious mind but also unfounded because before completion of my probationary period the Board of Management found my performance to be satisfactory and not only that I was confirmed to the post in question.

10. Save as would appear from admitted records and save as expressly admitted by me hereinafter I deny each and every allegation contained in paragraphs 40 to 44 of the said Petition. The Writ Petitioners have no existing right and /or any legal grievance to move this application.

11. With reference to the submission made in paragraphs 45 to 47 are baseless, vague and not tenable in the eye of law.

12. With reference to the submission made in paragraphs 48 to 51 of the said Petition I submit that those are vague and disputed ad-seriatim.

13. Statements made in paragraphs 1 to 4 of this affidavit are true to my knowledge, those made in paragraphs 4 to 8 thereof are based on information derived from the records of the case which I verily believe to be true and the rest are my humble submissions before this
