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

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NOTICE TO HAWLEY BOROUGH RESIDENTS

Notice is hereby given that the Hawley Borough Council shall hold a hearing for purposes of amending Ordinance No. 2-2018 which regulates residential non-owner-occupied units within the Borough on July 10, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. at the Hawley Borough Municipal Building located at 94 Main Avenue, Hawley, PA 18428.

The full text of the Ordinance Amendments are as follows:

Section 5 Duties of Borough Secretary

The Borough Secretary, or designee, under authority of this ordinance shall:

Section 6 Inspections. In the event of a new tenancy, the owner shall report the same to the Borough and an inspection of the premises shall be required by the Borough Rental Inspector.

Section 8 Enforcement. The Borough Rental Inspector, under authority of this Ordinance, shall be responsible for enforcing this Ordinance including, but not limited to, issuing or revocation of a license, the Rental Inspector shall determine violations requiring correction of said violations within 30 days and refer said violations, following the issuance of a violation notice, to Borough Council and the Borough Solicitor for the filing of a civil complaint.

Please note that all changes or additions are underlined, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall not change and shall remain in full force and effect. Paragraphs following paragraph 5 have been renumbered to reflect new paragraph 6.

All interested residents are invited to attend and comment on said amendment. The full text of the Amended Ordinance is available for inspection at the Borough Building during normal business hours Monday through Friday.
