INFORMATION AND RULES

This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the Rules of the USEF. The official Federation rulebook will prevail for this show. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of these rules and is subject to these rules. Any changes or corrections of the rules will automatically become part of this prize list. **Questions that may arise that are not covered by the USEF rulebook will be decided by the Show Committee and their decisions will be final.**

Memberships:

NO memberships are required

WDAA Memberships: All owners and riders competing to qualify for WDAA lifetime points or WDAA Year End High Point program MUST be a member of WDAA to be eligible for WDAA lifetime points program. You may learn more about the lifetime points program and about membership at www.westerndressageassociation.org.

Entries: Open to all breeds. All entries need entry form, coggins, flu/rhino certificate, liability release, and fees. Entries must be submitted through PAWDA show entry page. Close of entry is August 23, 2026. Entries postmarked after August 23, 2026 are considered a post entry and will be charged a fee of \$25 per horse. No refunds after the close date for any reason.

Final ride times will be posted on PAWDA website by noon the day prior to the show

Ride times not to start before 1pm. Ride time requests are accepted.

HELMETS required while mounted due to facility and insurance regulations

Per USEF rules:

Tack and bits on both sides of the horse of a minimum of one-third (1/3) of the horses in each class/test must be inspected.

- a. Once the exhibitor leaves the arena, the exhibitor must remain mounted until they reach the C2 Steward or equipment inspector. At that time, the exhibitor will dismount for the equipment inspection. Competitors will be asked to drop the bridle of the horse, removing the bit to below the mouth of the horse. A metal detector and/or magnet may be used to detect the presence of the metal in nosebands. Random pulling of leg wraps will also occur at this time. See also WD120.
- b. Any evidence of blood on the horse's mouth or sides or the addition of substances or devices behind wraps or boots will result in elimination of the entry for that class/test.
- c. The checking of the bridle must be done with the greatest caution, as some horses are very touchy and sensitive about their mouths.
- d. New disposable gloves must be available for and used by bit inspectors if a mouthpiece must be handled by the inspector.
- e. The responsibility for the correct attire and equipment rests with the competitor.

Bridle Numbers: All horses (competing and non-competing) must wear show numbers. Numbers will be provided at check in. PAWDA appreciates if bridle numbers are returned, it helps us keep costs down!

Scoring and Awards:

It is the responsibility of the competitor to verify the accuracy of all scores.

Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

Ribbons will be awarded 1st through 6th place per class and division.

Western Dressage Tests: Current 2022 WDAA Western Dressage Tests will be used. Warm up is in a covered indoor arena. Lunging round pen is available. All rides will be in the large arena. (20x60 meter). **NO WARMUP or LUNGING in PARKING AREA. Riders may NOT school their horse in any area except the designated warm up arena. Riders schooling the horse outside the designated areas will be given a warning, repeat violation may be cause for dismissal from the show.**

No trainers or helpers within the warm up arena.

Please respect and care for the beautiful property grounds, we are visitors and we want to come back!

Maximum tests per horse: Horses in this competition are limited to four tests per day.

Level restrictions: Horses may only compete in levels that are adjacent with the same rider. For example, a horse may not be ridden in a basic level test and a level 2 test unless with a different rider

NO DOGS allowed on show grounds

Refunds: Refunds BEFORE closing date minus office fee. Refunds after closing date: No refunds will be given for scratches for any reason. No refunds will be given due to canceled classes or show in the event of hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies out of the control of the show organizer.

Stalls: None is available

Horse Health Requirements: All horses must present a current negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show, Flu and Rhino vaccines within 6 months. Out of state horses need a CVI dated within 30 days of the show per Pennsylvania state law.

WDAA Lifetime Points Program

The WDAA Horse Lifetime Points and Awards Program is a voluntary pay-to-participate program in which owners submit Western Dressage Tests, Rail Class, and Equitation Pattern results in order to earn and track Lifetime Points for their horse. The WHLPAP also provides exclusive **VIP-style benefits**, such as physical milestone awards and an annual Awards Banquet at the WDAA World Championship Show. The WHLPAP is all about recognizing the growth and accomplishments of the dedicated horses in the program. Share your Journey and track your horse's Western Dressage career milestones and earn beautiful, customized Lifetime Awards celebrating your horse's achievements in Western Dressage.

Who is eligible to participate in the WHLPAP Program?

The WDAA Horse Lifetime Points and Awards Program is open to all horses, ponies, and mules, regardless of breed, type, or age. Participation in the WHLPAP requires current WDAA membership for both the horse owner and all exhibitors.

How is WHLPAP different from the Year End High Point Program (YEHP)?

The WDAA offers two horse-focused point programs: the Year-End High Point Program (YEHP-IYEHP) and the WDAA Horse Lifetime Points and Awards Program (WHLPAP). The YEHP recognizes annual achievements, awarding points based on a horse's performance over a single competition year. The WHLPAP, a voluntary pay-to-participate program, tracks lifetime points and provides exclusive VIP-style benefits, such as milestone awards and event recognition.

WDAA Year End Points Program

The WDAA Year-End High Point Program (YEHP) is a program that recognizes horses that excel in Western Dressage competition over the course of a competition year. Through the YEHP, horses earn points based on their performance at WDAA-recognized shows, with awards and recognition given to high-achieving horses in various divisions and levels. This program is free for members, offering a way for competitors to track their horse's progress and accomplishments year-over-year. Non-WDAA members are not eligible to participate in YEHP.

Points for the Year-End High Point (YEHP) Program are automatically calculated from official show results submitted by show secretaries.

To be eligible, the *horse must be enrolled* with either a **free WDAA horse number** or enrolled in **WHL PAP**, and *both the owner and all exhibitors must be active WDAA members* at the time of the ride.

LIABILITY: You assume the risk of equine activities pursuant to Pennsylvania Law. PAWDA release of liability form must be signed and submitted with entry or presented to show secretary upon arrival to the facility.

INDEMNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY: All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither PAWDA, WDAA, USEF, Painted Dreams Farm, the Show, the Show Committee, nor any Show Official will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, and the exhibitor shall indemnify the above mentioned parties against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including, but not limited to, any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. Submitting any entry form to the Show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing the same of the provisions herein set forth.

Show Rules: All classes will be conducted in accordance with the rules of USEF and WDAA. Judging, class specifications, rules and conduct shall be in accordance with the current USEF Rulebook. All decisions made by the Judge and/or Show Management are final and cannot be protested. Show Management reserves the right to ask any exhibitor to leave the show grounds for any reason including but not limited to: unsportsmanlike conduct and animal cruelty.

Refusal of Entries: The Show Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally or to cancel any entries of any exhibitor.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT



For and in consideration of Pennsylvania Western Dressage Association (PAWDA) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer, guardian) in a PAWDA sanctioned or associated event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and; I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the **"Agreement"**):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand and agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of WDAA and PAWDA as an affiliate of WDAA, published in the WDAA Rule Book and Protocols on the website at www.westerndressageassociation.org and www.PAWDA.org, as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any PAWDA Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; equipment failure and failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the PAWDA Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (**"Risks"**).

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. **ASSUMPTION OF RISK:** I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the PAWDA Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any PAWDA Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any PAWDA Event.

D. **WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY:** In conjunction with my participation in any PAWDA Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: PAWDA, PAWDA board members, PAWDA members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, volunteers and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any PAWDA Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the PAWDA Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a PAWDA Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature (**"Liability"**) which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the PAWDA Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. **COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE:** This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any PAWDA Event. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.
