Academic Excellence for our Diverse Student Population

Whitman continues to work hard to close achievement gaps and in 2024, Whitman Multilingual Learners scored the highest in English Learner Progress and Proficiency metrics for FCPS: 12.1% above the county average and a 34.7% jump from the previous school year.

Aligning with the FCPS Strategic Plan, Whitman's commitment to providing rigor to all students includes a full-time Advanced Academic Program cohort for designated students, in addition to core content Honors classes and IB MYP curriculum in all classes.

Preparing Students for College and Career


