Just a reminder that we will begin uniform referrals, starting on September 24. Please be sure your child is dressed in proper uniform each day. They need to have shirts tucked in, and be wearing belts with non-elastic waist pants. Also, on regular uniform days, tennis shoes must have dark soles. Please use a permanent marker to darken soles and logos, if necessary. Sweatshirts can be worn on gym days during the school day; however, on regular uniform days, sweatshirts will need to be put in lockers once students enter the building. If your child is cold, they will need to wear either a uniform sweater, or long sleeved uniform shirt. Socks need to be worn everyday, and the socks need to show. Socks must be navy, white, or black.
