Basketball season is officially over. The Varsity Boys played well, and got 2nd place in the Vicariate Tournament. Great job to our Saints on a great season!

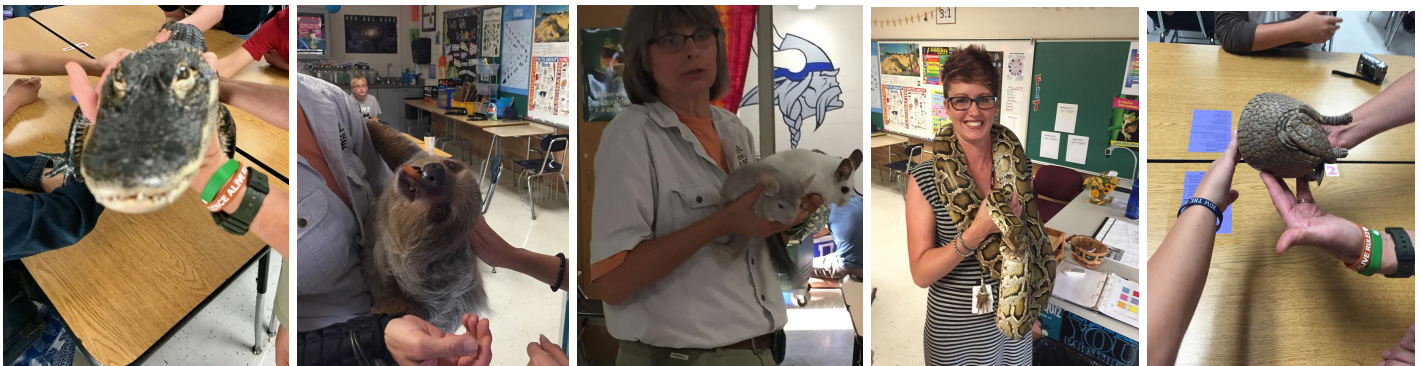
