

PRE-FIELD TRIP INFO



What's included (\$7 per child):

Each child will be able to explore Relleke activities (listed below), take a hay ride, feed the animals, and leave with a pie pumpkin!

- Hay Pyramid
- Corn pit
- Spider town
- Toddler Town
- Human Hamster wheels
- A-maze-ing Corn Palace
- Jungle Maze





DAY-OF INSTRUCTIONS





Arrive at the pumpkin patch:

(519 Sand Prairie Rd Granite City, IL 62040)

Make sure you get a final count of how many children and parents you brought with you (see next slide for additional parents/children).

Check in at the front desk in order to pay for your trip and collect what you need to feed the animals and do your hayride. We accept cash, card, or check.

Keep your group together for these steps!



Additional Parents and Children:

- Additional parents that the school or group is not paying for are \$2 if they choose to do the hayride.
 They will buy their hayride ticket at the front counter while you check in.
- Additional children who attend and are not paid for by the school or group will purchase a \$7 wristband at the front counter to be included in all field trip activities.



Please note that we have multiple groups at the patch at a time. To make sure everyone in your group gets to ride the hay ride and that we are efficient as possible, keep your group together and board the hay ride all at once! Workers will be there to collect your hayride tickets. If you have a big group, we will

do multiple rides if needed.


Hay Ride Details

We do require that at least one adult rides the hay ride with your children. Additionally, note that the hay ride does not stop in the field. It is a continuous loop and takes between 8 and 10 minutes. If your group doesn't fit on one ride, the wait shouldn't be too long!



Feeding the Animals

Whoever checks your group in will receive one ticket per child for a cup of animal feed. This can be done together as a group after your hayride or separately, however, children will need their ticket to receive the cup of food. If you choose to do this separately, your coordinator will have to hand each child their ticket so that they can redeem them when they want! The animal food station will be located on the patio near the front desk where you checked in under the large awning.




AFTER YOU USE YOUR TICKETS



After your hayride and animal feeding:

Your children are free to explore! The front counter will be open for sales (pumpkins, drinks, snacks, crafts, etc.). Please make sure each group/ child is accompanied by an adult.





LUNCHES


PRE PAID LUNCHES:

If you ordered lunches for your group upon booking, you will receive lunch tickets when you check in. Take those to the food truck area to pick up lunches when you are ready!

- Lunches include a hotdog, chips, and juice.
- If you did not order lunches and are interested in doing so, please call the farm phone to add lunches if they are available on your date.
- NOTE: you must pay for however many lunches you ordered, so if there is any change in numbers, call and let us know!







LUNCHES

DIDN'T ORDER LUNCHES?

We do allow outside food and drink if you would like to bring your own. On busy days, 1-2 food trucks may open if they are serving lunches that day. This depends on the number of field trips and whether any other schools ordered lunches, so it is not guaranteed. We do sell snacks and drinks at the front counter.

Are rides open during the week?

Rides do not open during the week.



Unfortunately, we no longer offer free pumpkins for teachers. However, teachers can purchase a pumpkin for a discounted price.

What time can we arrive?

We allow groups to arrive as early as 9 in the morning and as late as 4 p.m.

How long are field trips at the patch?

Your field trip is self guided, so that is up to you! Groups typically spend about 2-3 hours here.
