WELCOME TO OUR BEAUTIFUL NEW SITE: SPARROW LAKE CAMP



"Sparrow Lake Camp is surrounded by over 2 km of shoreline on Ontario's beautiful Sparrow Lake, which is part of the Trent-Severn Waterway System connecting Lake Ontario to Georgian Bay. The lake is a popular spot for boaters and anglers, and a great place to cool off on a hot summer day." - Sparrow Lake Camp

For anyone camping overnight, there are 126 mixed wooded and open acres to explore! Check out our map for acceptable camping areas. The campsites around the peninsula on the shores of Sparrow Lake are little bits of paradise! These sites are removed from the main camp, and afford excellent privacy from others on shore, while being open to the lake along the shore. You may also camp on the south shoreline, in the area around P2 and in the grassy area near the Great Hall.

"Built in 1927, Sparrow Lake Camp's beautiful "Cabin Row" is a source of much pride. With 13 original cabins as well as the newer "Leadership Academy", Cabin Row has 182 bunks in total. Cabins are unheated with large screened windows to keep bugs out and allow breezes in during the summer months. Each cabin has an electrical outlet, hard-wired smoke detectors, and fire extinguisher. " - Sparrow Lake Camp

The dining hall is equipped with a full size kitchen and plenty of seating. We will have breakfast and dinner available for those who wish to purchase a meal pass, or who wish to purchase individual meals. Please visit Admin to purchase meal passes if you have not done so already.

"The main washhouse is equipped with toilets, sinks, and showers, separated by gender. Additional individual portable restroom facilities are situated around the camp as well." - Sparrow Lake Camp

INTRO TO RUNES (THE ELDER FUTHARK SYSTEM)

This will be a unique Harvest-Fest only condensed version of my online 2-hour workshop that I teach via Happy Soul Academy

I will be teaching the basics and brief history for each of the 24 runes for the Elder Futhark system; the earliest runic system before it branched off to other rune formats throughout England and Scandinavian

territories. I will be giving keywords and lore behind each rune and a physical "cheat sheet" at the end of the workshop to those who want a reference guide for doing their own studies and divination. Laurie Benson has led Herb Walks and Talks from Starwood to Kaleidoscope, after being inspired by the Wic-Can Fest walks Nick Faunus led in the '80's. She went on to work for Faunus Herbs, studied with Susun Weed and was initiated by her as a Green Witch in the '90's. Laurie has completed her 500 hour Advanced Yoga Teacher status through international training in Costa Rica, Mexico and India and teaches Yoga and Practical Herbalism from her home in Cannington and at Festivals.

HERB WALKS

Tour this majestic site to get to know our plant allies and their edible, medicinal and magikal attributes. As foraging and wildcrafting become more popular, it is important to know who is who in the plant world! This walk will take about an hour unless there is interest to continue for another. I will let people know who wish to attend the next workshop scheduled when the first hour is nearly up and then there is a possibility to continue further. We keep to the roads and paths (I will show you Poison Ivy that is off the path!) so there aren't too many challenges in the first part, but there are some rocky climbs near the lake that we can tackle as well.

HOW TO MAKE A HERBAL DRINKING VINEGAR



What's the difference between tinctures, oxymels, shrubs and switzle? All are names for different drinking vinegars with healing and nourishing properties and some are tasty enough to make into mocktails and cocktails! We will talk about the healing gifts of the herbs traditionally used, how we can be creative with our mixes, and get to sample some of the drinks. You will also get a sample bottle to collect your own herbs in and extract their goodness in organic apple cider vinegar!



SACHET MAKE A HERBAL DREAM SACHET

Traditionally herbs have been combined in a little bag or sachet to help with prophetic or lucid dreaming, bring easy sleep and banish nightmares. All ages can create their own magikal herbal blend (several dried "dream herbs" will be supplied) to be placed in a cloth with some essential oil, beads or other decorations. If you have any special gemstones, ribbons or items to include, bring them along! There will be only as much sewing as you want to do, so this can be as guick and easy or as deep and meditative as you wish. Lists of herbs and their dream influences will be supplied in case you want to explore this further!


Wulf will be hosting a mask making workshop in anticipation of the Witches & Wizards Ball!






CATHERINE STARR

Root through my essential oil stock and make a blend of your very own, beginner to advanced. Children must be accompanied by an adult.



Anyone violating these rules will be expelled without refund. Thank you for being honorable!



- No child under age 12 may be left unattended near ANY body of water on the site. Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
- No sexually aggressive or **inappropriate behavior** will be tolerated on the site. It is prohibited to wander through the site at large while skyclad.
- NO Glass at the Firepit!
- Except at the discretion of the Festival, **no electrically amplified instruments** may be used.
- Video cameras are not permitted and will be confiscated.
- It is also against the festival rules to photograph anyone without their prior consent. This also means: no Ritual or group shots. Cell phones, iPads and the likes, are not permitted at the main fire, for the same reason.
- **Smoking** is strictly forbidden in all cabins and in the dining hall. It is permitted to smoke elsewhere on the site provided you dispose of your cigarette butts in an environmentally friendly way. (Use the Butt Cans provided).

CAN I DRINK THE WATER?

Drinking water will be available in the kitchen. If no one is there, please feel free to fill up your drinking receptacles at the sink. Please do not drink the water from the washroom faucets

CAN I CREATE A FIREPIT AT MY CAMPSITE IF ONE DOESN'T ALREADY EXIST?

No! It is absolutely forbidden to create any new fire pits. You must use the pre-existing ones or bring an above ground metal campfire basin including its screen (to suppress flying sparks). It is not permitted to dig or create any additional fire pits or to collect ANY living vegetation for firewood.

ARE THERE TOILET & SHOWER FACILITIES?

Yes, we have full, hot showers, bathrooms and public bathrooms available on site as well as outhouses in the camping areas. Do not flush ANYTHING in the toilets, except for human waste, and only pee is allowed in the urinals. The plumbing of the facility is fragile and septic pumping fees are outrageous. Therefore, use the garbage bins. There shall be NO washing of any kind, including hair, bodies, clothing etc, in the river
