Playwright's Note: Periodically, the action comes to a point of crisis or revelation. At this point, Jerry appears and the audience is asked to choose from a small list of options. Feel free to explore how to best work this: either through group vote (applause), choosing a specific audience member, or some other way. It is important this process go quickly, so as to not kill the overall flow of the play.

Theme music. A funky coffee shop. Tom is sitting drinking a latte and reading a local alternative paper. Periodically he looks up from his paper, searching for someone who is obviously late. In rushes Amy, who throws her bag on the chair opposite Tom.

(Once a clear winner has been established.)
