Pray

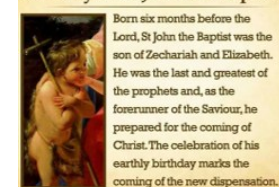
Why all these thoughts? Why all these doubts?

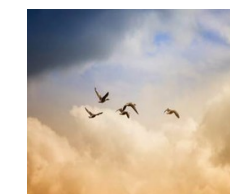
