14TH DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: *Our rest comes in walking side-by-side with Christ.*

The God who defeated death – this mighty one whose dominion shall be from sea to sea – promises to carry our burdens with us, to never leave us alone in our struggles, to humble himself to walk beside us in our smallness and our need. Our rest comes in walking side-by-side with Christ.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the prophet Zechariah tells of the king who will come riding on an ass to proclaim peace to the nations. In the epistle, we are told that the Spirit of the one who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in us. In the Gospel, Jesus praises the Father for revealing the hidden things to little ones. He invites those who labor to rest in him.

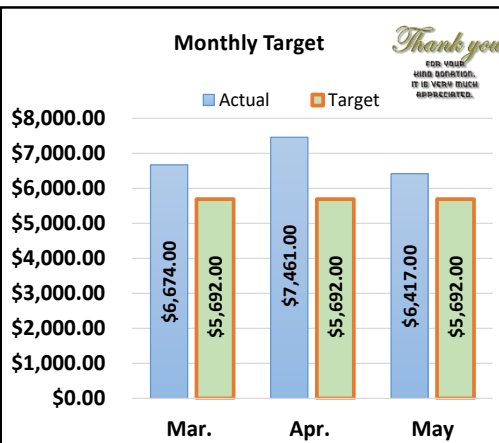
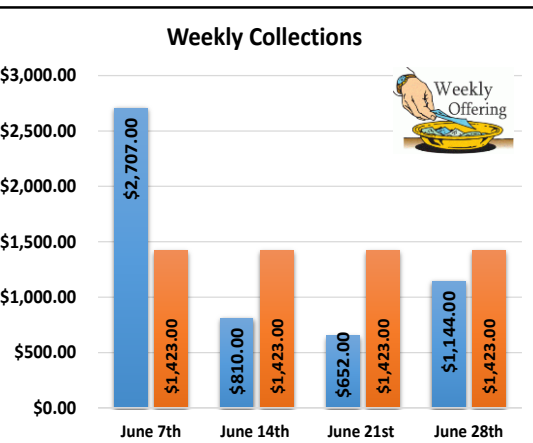
