Our readings are chosen to help us reflect on this great truth and be prepared for the coming of Christ.

In a time of great upheaval and chaos for Israel, Jeremiah reassures the people of better days to come, when a descendent of David will rule them with integrity and honesty. Looking forward to the return of Christ in glory, Saint Paul reminds us that we must strive for true holiness now. In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that no matter what befalls us in this life, we are to have confidence in him, the Son of Man.

Daily Reflections for Advent & Christmas Week 1

<u>Sunday Dec. 2</u>– **Be Not Afraid!** People will die of fright in anticipation of what is coming upon the world...And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand. (Lk 21:26-27) *Prayer: Come, Lord Jesus!*

Monday Dec. 3-Lost in the Dark— O house of Jacob, come, let us walk in the light of the Lord@ (Isa 2:5) *Prayer:* Lord Jesu, Light of the World, be a lamp to our feet as we walk through the lengthening dark toward the light that shines from the manger on Christmas Day.

<u>Tuesday Dec. 4-No Harm or Hurt on God's Mountain-</u>"Blessed are the eyes that see what you see." (Lk 10:23) *Prayer: Christ, our peace, let us see your face, let us learn your way, let us grow into your love that we may serve the birth of true peace in our immediate surroundings.*

Wednesday Dec. 5-Everybody come!-On this mountain the Lord of hosts will provide for all peoples A feast of rich food and choice wines, juicy, rich food and pure, choice wines. On this mountain he will destroy...death forever. The Lord God will wipe away the tears from all faces. (Isa 25:6-7) **Prayer:** O God, Giver of all Good gifts, open our hearts to trust your word, your promise, your desire to include us at the feast on the mountain, and your abiding love that calls, heals, and feeds us always.

<u>Thursday Dec. 6</u>-**How Firm a Foundation!-**"Everyone who listens to these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and buffeted the house. But it did not collapse; it had been set solidly on rock." (Matt 7:24-25) *Prayer:* Christ our Rock, hold us fast in faith when the rains fall, the floods come, and the winds of life blow. Let us trust and hold on!

<u>Friday Dec. 7-What Do You See?-Then [Jesus]</u> touched their eyes and said, "Let it be done for you according to your faith." And their eyes were opened. (Matt 9:29-30) *Prayer:* O Christ, living Word of God, open our eyes to see you more clearly, love you more dearly, and follow you more nearly.

Saturday Dec. 8-About-Face!-Blessed be the God and Father or our Lord Jesus Christ, as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and without blemish before him. (Eph 1:3-4) *Prayer:* O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for me that I may turn away from myself and toward Christ.
