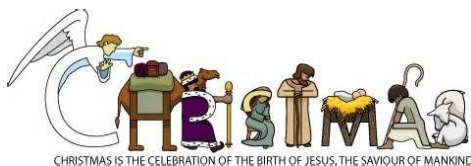
2019 COLLECTION ENVELOPES

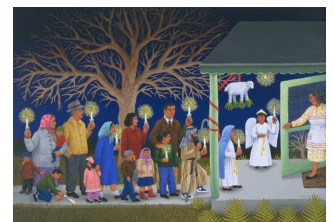


LAS POSADAS

SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT

FOCUS: As we await the coming of our Lord and Savior, joy and hope fill our hearts in anticipation of the Messiah.

Prepare the way of the Lord! Today marks the Second Sunday of Advent, and we are filled with hope, joy and anticipation. The Lord enters the world to save us. Our paths will be made straight. Our burdens will be eased. Our darkness will be lightened. Salvation is at hand.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The first reading calls Israel to abandon mourning and misery and replace it with the glorious splendor of God. Paul's Letter to the Philippians is filled with hope and joy, embracing Christ's message and mission. Hope continues in the Gospel as John prepares the way of the Lord, baptizing in his name and proclaiming that salvation is near.

Daily Reflections for Advent & Christmas Week 1

Sunday Dec. 9--Homecoming- Up, Jerusalem! Stand upon the heights; look to the east and see your children gathered from the east and the west... Led away on foot by their enemies they left you: but God will bring them back to you borne aloft in glory as on royal thrones. (Bar 5:5-6) **Prayer:** O Christ, you promised to prepare a place for us and return to take us there. Make our hearts and our lives ready to go with you.

Monday Dec. 10-The High Road- A highway will be there, called the holy way; No one unclean may pass over it... [A]nd on it the redeemed will walk. Those whom the Lord has ransomed will return and enter Zion singing, crowned with everlasting joy. (Isa 25:8, 10) **Prayer:** Jesus, Great Healer, let us all walk home joyfully on the highway of the redeemed, helping one another as we go.

Tuesday Dec. 11-The Shepherd- "If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them goes astray, will he not leave the ninety-nine in the hills and go in search of the stray?" (Matt 18:12) **Prayer:** Christ, Good Shepherd, stay with us, guard us, guide us always! Bring us safely home!

Wednesday Dec. 12-Mother to Us All- "And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me??" (Lk 1:43) **Prayer:** Our Lady of Guadalupe, mother of the world, pray for us!

Thursday Dec. 13-Thirsty?- The afflicted and the needy seek water in vain, their tongues are parched with thirst. I, the Lord, will answer them... (Isa 41:17) **Prayer:** O God, Giver of all good gifts, let even the clouds that sometimes darken our life rain down the Just One and fill our parched moments with living water!

Friday Dec. 14-New Song, New Dance- "To what shall I compare this generation? It is like children who sit in marketplaces and call to one another, 'We played the flute for you, but you did not dance, we sang a dirge but you did not mourn.' " (Matt 11:16) **Prayer:** O Christ, God's living love song to a world in turmoil, open our hearts' ears to hear you and follow your lead in the daily dance.

Saturday Dec. 16-The Advent Balance- [L]ike a fire there appeared the prophet Elijah whose words were as a flaming furnace. By the Lord's word he shut up the heavens and three times brought down fire. (Sir 48:1, 3) **Prayer:** O Spirit of God, fire of life, burn away in us all that keeps us from receiving Christ and living fully in him!
