



SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

FOCUS: *The Transfiguration is a sign of hope.*

The Transfiguration is a sign of hope. When Jesus was transfigured before his disciples, they had a glimpse of the glorified future that awaits the faithful. Through the power of Jesus Christ, we can be transformed, leading the holy lives to which he calls us. Filled with his light and goodness, we will shine with his glory in this life and in the world to come.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, God calls Abram from his homeland and promises to make of him a great nation. The reading from the Second Letter of Timothy explains that God calls us to holiness through the grace of Christ. In the Gospel Peter, James, and John see Jesus transfigured and speaking with Moses and Elijah. As they descended from the mountain, Jesus tells them not to tell anyone of the vision.

ENFOQUE: *La Transfiguración es un signo de esperanza.*

La lectura de la Segunda Carta de Timoteo explica que Dios nos llama a la santidad por la gracia de Cristo. En el Evangelio, Pedro, Santiago y Juan ven a Jesús transfigurado y hablando con Moisés y Elías. Al descender de la montaña, Jesús les dice que no cuenten a nadie la visión.




