




Pray

THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT

TERCERO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

FOCUS: *We are invited to bring our thirst to God.*

In the sacred season of Lent, we are invited to acknowledge our thirst and our need for God. Let us not mask it or hide it with distractions or goods which cannot ultimately satisfy. We are invited instead to bring our thirst to God and, like the Samaritan woman, simply ask: Lord, give me this water, the water which will make us never thirst again.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The first reading recounts how the Israelites, in their thirst, grumbled against Moses and God provided water from the rock. In the second reading, Paul writes to the Romans that they have been justified by faith and that hope does not disappoint. In the Gospel, Jesus meets the Samaritan woman at the well and invites her to receive living water.

ENFOQUE: *Estamos invitados a llevar nuestra sed a Dios.*

En el tiempo sagrado de la Cuaresma, se nos invita a reconocer nuestra sed y nuestra necesidad de Dios. No la enmascaremos ni la ocultemos con distracciones o bienes que, en última instancia, no pueden satisfacernos. En lugar de ello, se nos invita a llevar nuestra sed a Dios y, como la mujer samaritana, simplemente pedir: Señor, dame esta agua, el agua que hará que nunca volvamos a tener sed.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

La primera lectura relata cómo, en su sed, los israelitas se quejaron contra Moisés y Dios les proporcionó agua de la roca. En la segunda lectura, Pablo escribe a los romanos que han sido justificados por la fe y que la esperanza no quedará defraudada. En el Evangelio, Jesús se encuentra con la mujer samaritana en el pozo y la invita a recibir agua viva.




