FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

CUARTO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

FOCUS: *Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness.*

By proclaiming the beatitudes, Jesus turns the world's values and expectations upside down. He tells us that the poor, the meek, and the hungry are at the center of God's kingdom, not the wealthy or powerful. God's ways are not our ways, and Jesus' words invite us to live by a different set of standards than the world offers. Those who hunger for God's ways will be satisfied.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

Through the prophet Zephaniah the Lord informs his people that he will guard and care for the humble and those who take refuge in his holy name. In the second reading, Paul writes that the Lord chooses to call those who seem foolish, weak, and despised in the eyes of the world. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus proclaims the beatitudes to the crowds.

ENFOQUE: *Felices los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia.*

Al proclamar las bienaventuranzas, Jesús pone patas arriba los valores y las expectativas del mundo. Nos dice que los pobres, los mansos y los hambrientos son el centro del reino de Dios, no los ricos ni los poderosos. Los caminos de Dios no son nuestros caminos, y las palabras de Jesús nos invitan a vivir según una serie de normas distintas de las que ofrece el mundo. Los que tienen hambre de los caminos de Dios quedarán satisfechos.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

A través del profeta Sofonías, el Señor informa a su pueblo que guardará y cuidará tanto a los humildes como a quienes se refugian en su santo nombre. En la segunda lectura, Pablo escribe que el Señor elige llamar a los que parecen necios, débiles y despreciados a los ojos del mundo. En el Sermón de la Montaña, Jesús proclama las bienaventuranzas a las multitudes.

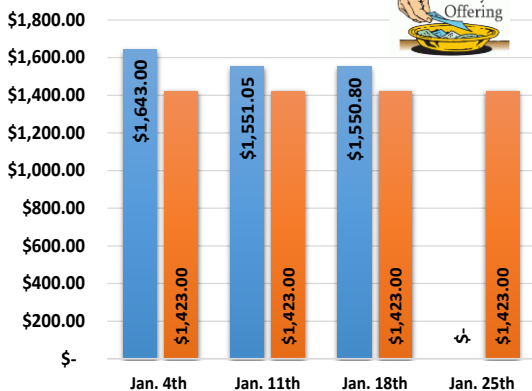

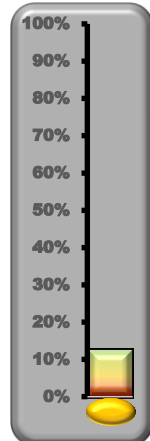
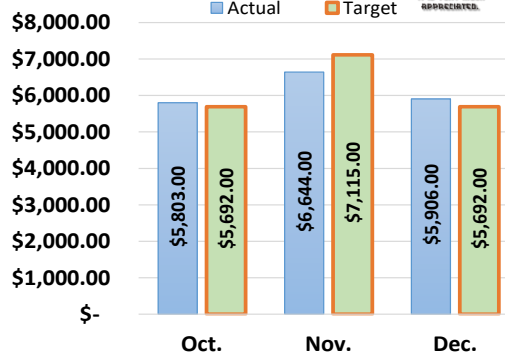
