EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD

DOMINGO DE PASCUA DE LA RESURRECCIÓN DEL SEÑOR

FOCUS: *We are a resurrection people who follow the risen Christ.*

The empty tomb is a sign of hope. Death does not have the final word. If our life with Christ can overcome even the seeming finality of death, God’s mercy can also overcome all pain and sorrow. If we bind ourselves to Christ, earthly suffering will be vanquished. We can rejoice and be glad with hearts full of peace.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Peter speaks of Jesus’ life, death and resurrection and says, we are witnesses of all that he did. In his Letter to the Colossians, Paul writes that our life is with Christ and we will one day appear with him in glory. In the Gospel, Mary of Magdala, Peter, and the other disciple whom Jesus loved find Jesus’ body missing from the tomb. John comes to believe in Christ’s resurrection.

ENFOQUE: *Somos un pueblo de resurrección que sigue a Cristo resucitado.*

La tumba vacía es un signo de esperanza. La muerte no tiene la última palabra. Si nuestra vida con Cristo puede superar incluso la aparente finalidad de la muerte, la misericordia de Dios también puede superar todo dolor y toda pena. Si nos unimos a Cristo, el sufrimiento terrenal será vencido. Podremos regocijarnos y alegrarnos con el corazón lleno de paz.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Pedro habla de la vida, muerte y resurrección de Jesús, y dice: “Nosotros somos testigos de todo lo que hizo”. En su Carta a los Colosenses, Pablo escribe que nuestra vida está con Cristo y que un día aparecer[emos] con él, llenos de gloria. En el Evangelio, María de Magdala, Pedro y el otro discípulo al que Jesús amaba encuentran el cuerpo de Jesús desaparecido de la tumba. Juan llega a creer en la resurrección de Cristo.

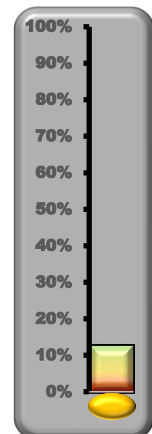
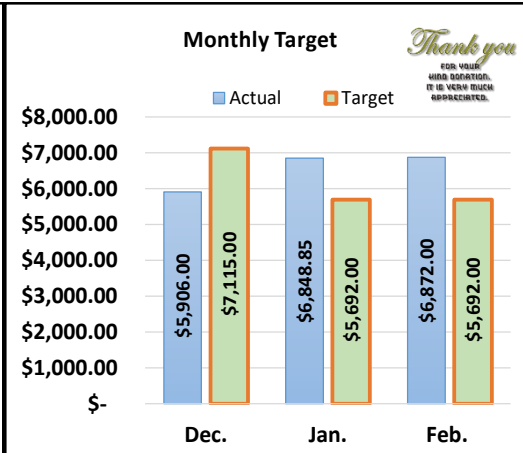
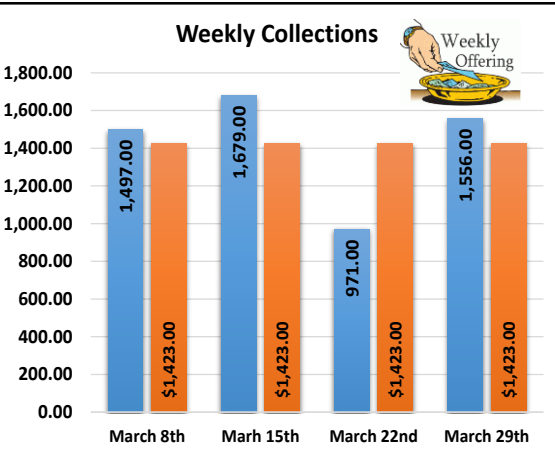
