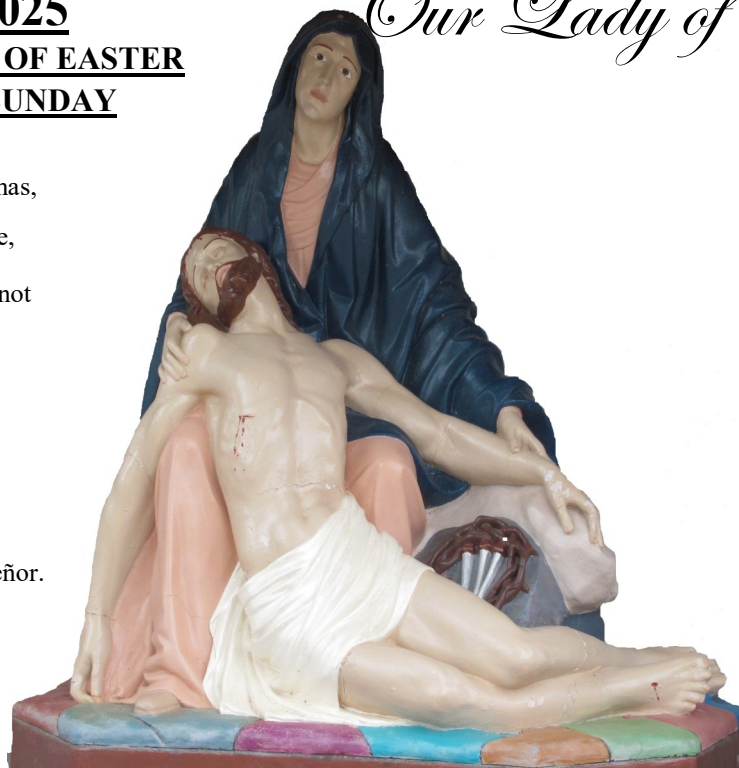

Conditions

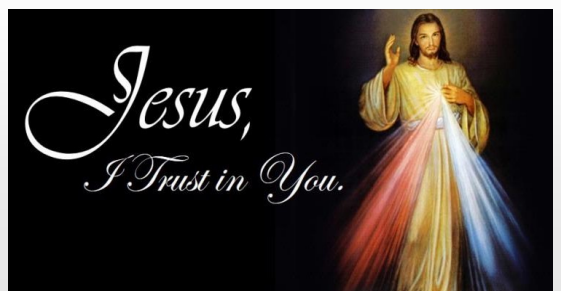
To earn the plenary indulgence, one must also confess and receive communion.

Divine Mercy Sunday - April 27th

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER (DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY) SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE PASCUA (LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA)

FOCUS: We must obey God rather than men.

In order to move forward, we need to look back. We need to remember, to be ready for what is to come. In the Mass, we are reminded of how Jesus offered himself for us; how he cares for and nourishes us; and how he guides us. With this remembrance, we can move forward in love to follow and serve him.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Peter and the Apostles are questioned and ordered by the Sanhedrin to stop teaching in Jesus' name. In the second reading, John has a vision of countless angels, living creatures, and elders crying out in praise to the Lamb of God. In the Gospel, Jesus appears at the sea to Peter and other disciples. Jesus instructs them to cast their net over the right side and they have a great catch of fish. Then he serves them breakfast, asks Peter three times if he loves him, and instructs Peter to feed his sheep and follow him.

ENFOQUE: Hay que obedecer a Dios antes que a los hombres.

Para avanzar, necesitamos mirar atrás. Necesitamos recordar, estar preparados para lo que está por venir. En la Misa, se nos recuerda cómo Jesús se ofreció por nosotros; cómo nos cuida y nos alimenta; también cómo nos guía. Con este recuerdo, podemos avanzar en el amor para seguirle y servirle.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, tanto Pedro como los Apóstoles son interrogados, y el Sanedrín les ordena que dejen de enseñar en nombre de Jesús. En la segunda lectura, Juan tiene una visión de innumerables ángeles, criaturas vivientes y ancianos que claman alabando al Cordero de Dios. En el Evangelio, Jesús se aparece en el mar a Pedro y a otros discípulos, y les ordena echar la red por el lado derecho, obteniendo una gran pesca. Luego les sirve el desayuno, le pregunta a Pedro tres veces si le ama y le ordena, no solo que apaciente a sus ovejas, sino que también le siga.

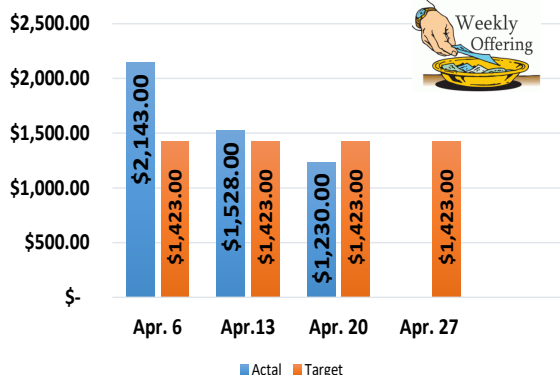

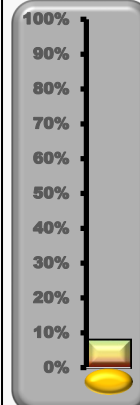
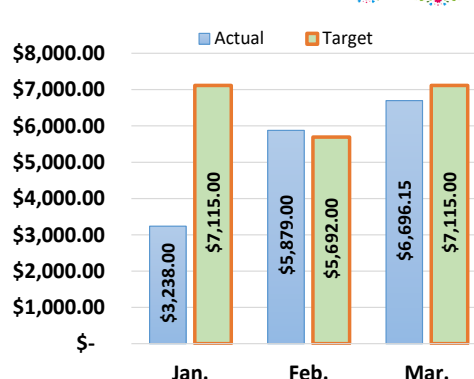
