FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

FESTIVIDAD DEL BAUTISMO DEL SEÑOR

FOCUS: Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit and power at his baptism.

The prophet Isaiah says that God's chosen one is called to be a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness. When the Spirit descended upon Christ at his baptism, these promises were fulfilled. But these promises aren't only for Jesus; we, too, are called to be signs and instruments of God's presence in the world.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies about the servant who will bring justice without breaking a bruised reed. In the second reading, Peter proclaims Jesus as the Lord of all, recounting the story of his baptism and ministry. In the Gospel, Jesus is baptized by John in the Jordan and the heavens were opened for him.

ENFOQUE: Jesús fue ungido con la fuerza del Espíritu Santo en su bautismo.

El profeta Isaías dice que el elegido de Dios está llamado a ser una luz de las naciones, para abrir los ojos de los ciegos, para hacer salir de la prisión a los cautivos y de la cárcel a los que habitan en las tinieblas. Cuando el Espíritu descendió sobre Cristo en su bautismo, estas promesas se cumplieron. Pero estas promesas no son sólo para Jesús; también nosotros estamos llamados a ser signos e instrumentos de la presencia de Dios en el mundo.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Isaías profetiza sobre el siervo que traerá la justicia sin romper una caña quebrada. En la segunda lectura, Pedro proclama a Jesús como el Señor de todos y relata la historia de su bautismo y de su ministerio. En el Evangelio, Jesús es bautizado por Juan en el Jordán y los cielos se abren para él.

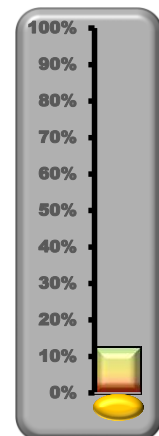
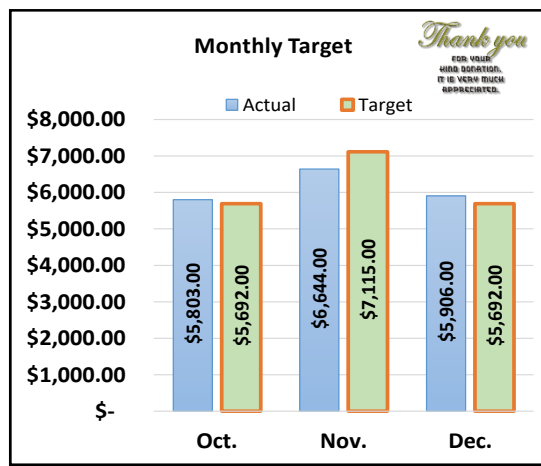
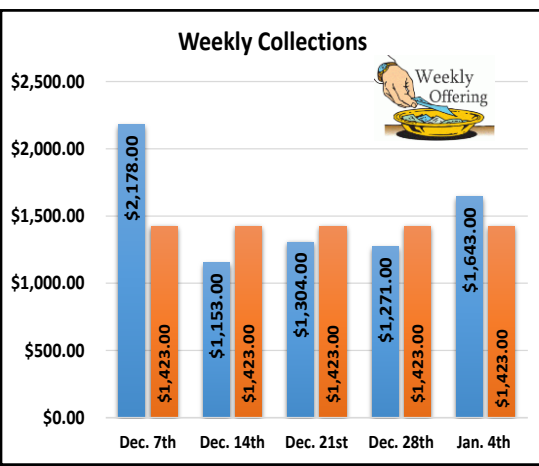
