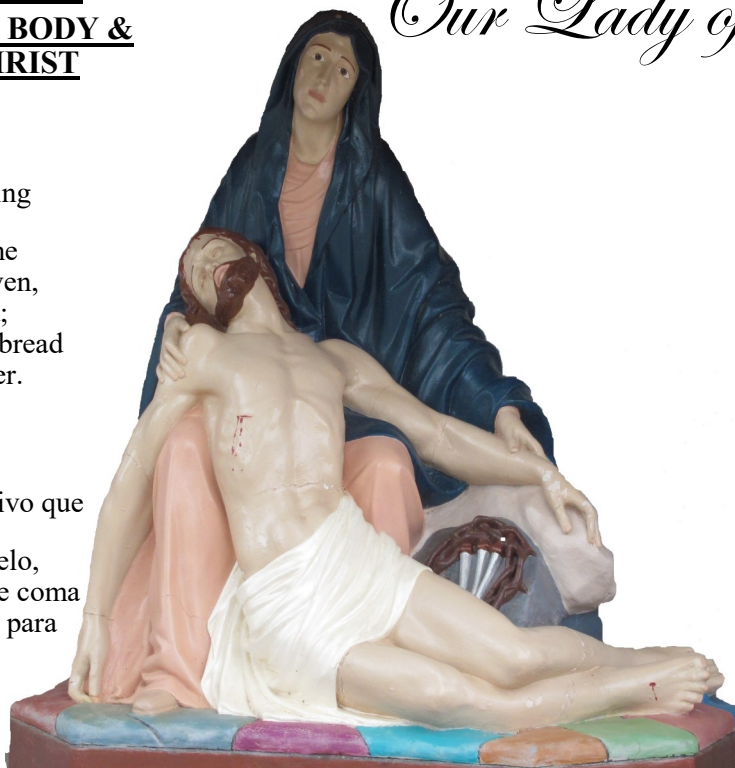

Corpus Christi, meaning "Body of Christ" in Latin, is a significant feast in the Catholic Church that celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It is a time for Catholics to publicly profess their faith in the belief that the bread and wine consecrated at Mass truly become the body and blood of Christ. The feast is a

celebration of Jesus's abiding presence with humanity and a reminder of his sacrifice and love. **Real Presence of Christ:** The core belief celebrated is that Jesus Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Eucharist, under the appearances of bread and wine. **Eucharist as the source and summit:** The feast emphasizes the Eucharist as the central sacrament in Christian life, the source of grace and the ultimate expression Christ's love. **Public Profession of Faith:** Corpus Christi processions and celebrations serve as a public demonstration of faith in the Real Presence and a reaffirmation of belief in the doctrine of transubstantiation. **Unity and Charity:** Celebrating the feast strengthens the bonds of unity among believers and encourages acts of charity and sacrifice, mirroring Christ's own actions. **Celebration of Christ's sacrifice:** It serves as a reminder of Jesus's sacrifice on the cross and his enduring love for humanity. **Historical Roots:** The feast originated from a Eucharistic miracle and the advocacy of Saint Juliana of Liege, who promoted the importance of the Eucharist.



THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST-CORPUS CHRISTI SANTÍSIMO CUERPO Y SANGRE DE CHRISTO-CORPUS CHRISTI

FOCUS: Jesus makes a gift of himself to us.

On the feast of Corpus Christi, the second reading offers the earliest account of the institution of the Eucharist. Jesus tells his disciples that his body and blood are given for them and commands them to do this in remembrance of me. Jesus provides more than a meal; he gives us his very self, broken for us on the cross. Every time Mass is offered, Jesus' sacrifice on the cross is re-presented and we are once again able to receive this gift of himself.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading Melchizedek, king of Salem, brought out bread and wine and blessed Abram. Then Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of everything. In the second reading, Paul tells the Corinthians that on the night Jesus was handed over, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and said, This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me. In the Gospel, the Twelve tell Jesus to dismiss the crowds so they can obtain food, but Jesus takes five loaves and two fish, blesses them, and feeds the crowd with them.

ENFOQUE: Jesús hace un don de sí mismo a nosotros.

En la fiesta del Corpus Christi, la segunda lectura ofrece el relato más antiguo de la institución de la Eucaristía. Jesús dice a sus discípulos que tanto su cuerpo como sangre se entregan por ellos y les ordena que hagan esto en memoria mía. Jesús nos da algo más que una comida; nos da su propio ser, roto por nosotros en la cruz. Cada vez que se ofrece la Misa, se vuelve a representar el sacrificio de Jesús en la cruz y podemos recibir de nuevo este don de sí mismo.

LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, Melquisedec, rey de Salem, sacó pan y vino, luego bendijo a Abram. Entonces Abram dio a Melquisedec la décima parte de todo. En la segunda lectura, Pablo cuenta a los corintios que la noche en que Jesús fue entregado, tomó pan, dio gracias, lo partió y dijo: Esto es mi cuerpo, que se entrega por ustedes. Hagan esto en memoria mía. En el Evangelio, los Doce le dicen a Jesús que despida a la multitud para que puedan conseguir comida, pero Jesús toma cinco panes y dos peces, los bendice y alimenta a la multitud con ellos.

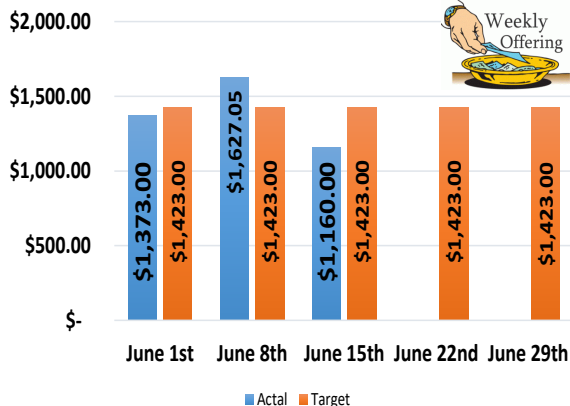

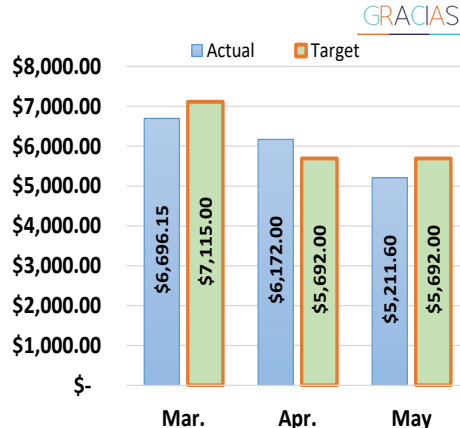

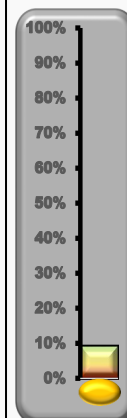
