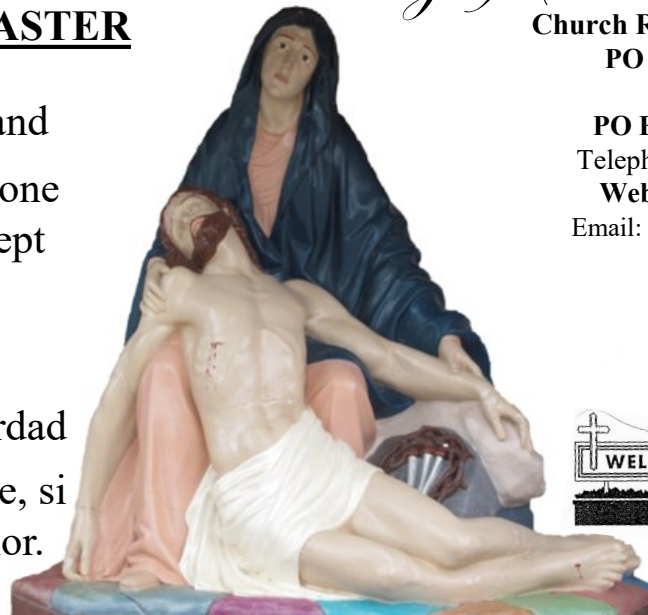

# FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER QUINTO DOMINGO DE PASCUA

**FOCUS:** God has made us a chosen race and a royal priesthood. In him we find our deepest identity.

The second reading from the First Letter of Peter provides a beautiful and yet challenging description of who we are as Christians. We are, by virtue of baptism, a chosen race, a royal priesthood, and a people set apart to give praise to God. Taken together, these statements remind us what a grace and privilege it is to be chosen, but they also reassure us of how God sees us and how we ought to see ourselves and others. Everything we do must reflect this holy and royal status.

## LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the Twelve choose from among the community the first deacons. In his Letter, Peter reminds the earliest Christians that they are part of a spiritual house, built on Christ the great cornerstone – a royal priesthood and holy nation. In the Gospel, Jesus encourages the disciples by promising to return and take them to his Father’s house.

**ENFOQUE:** Dios nos ha hecho una raza elegida y un sacerdocio real. En Él encontramos nuestra identidad más profunda.

La segunda lectura de la Primera Carta de Pedro ofrece una descripción hermosa y, a la vez, desafiante de lo que somos como cristianos. Somos, en virtud del bautismo, una raza elegida, un sacerdocio real y un pueblo apartado para alabar a Dios. En conjunto, estas afirmaciones nos recuerdan la gracia y el privilegio que supone ser elegidos, pero también nos aseguran cómo nos ve Dios y cómo debemos vernos a nosotros mismos, así como a los demás. Todo lo que hagamos debe reflejar esta condición santa y real.

## LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA

En la primera lectura, los Doce eligen a los primeros diáconos entre la comunidad. En su Carta, Pedro recuerda a los primeros cristianos que forman parte de una casa espiritual, edificada sobre Cristo, la gran piedra angular: un sacerdocio real y una nación santa. En el Evangelio, Jesús anima a los discípulos prometiéndoles que volverá y los llevará a la casa de su Padre.

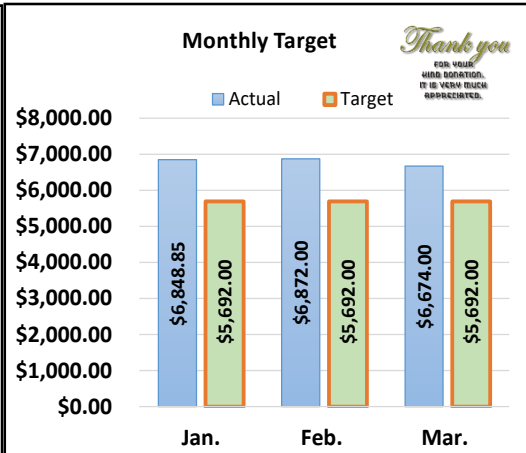
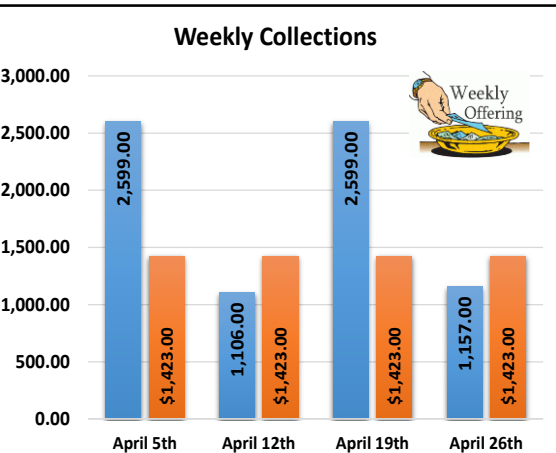
